

**ENTRY PROCESS**



All entries shall be made electronically via the FINA General Management System (GMS) via the link <https://data.fina.org> by the deadline of September 27, 2021. Access to the registration system should be via the logins previously supplied to your Federation. For logistical purposes, please make sure to enter the CORRECT travel information in the FINA GMS. The LOC will organize the transportation according to the flight details entered in the system. ### ROOM & BOARD PACKAGES

The HMF/OC shall provide accommodation in a minimum 4-star hotel with full-board (3 meals per day of adequate quantity and quality) for a minimum of 2 athletes and 1 team leader/coach for each of the other HMF's of the SWC as follows:

- Neighbouring countries – for 5 nights
- Same continent – for 5 nights
- Another continent – for 6 nights

All other participating National FINA Member Federations are responsible for their own swimming team's accommodation and board expenses.

Single room	USD 260 (full board) per night /per room
Double room	USD 380 (full board) per night /per room

Preliminary accommodation requests have to be submitted by **10 September 2021** (by sending an email to [Laszlo.szogi@musz.hu](mailto:Laszlo.szogi@musz.hu)). To avoid cancellation charges the Accommodation section must be notified of any amendments or cancellation by **22 September 2021** the latest. Please note that the two hotels are identical and are located next to each other. Therefore, places will be allocated by the Accommodation department of the OC based on occupancy and team size.

### COVID-19 PROTOCOL

As of 31 August 2021, Hungary is one of the countries with the lowest number of daily cases. Travelling to Hungary is safe, but a strict protocol has to be followed. Please check the entry requirements regularly at Hungary's embassy/consulate in your country, which can be found here: <https://konzuliszolgalat.kormany.hu/hu-missions-abroad>

The Organizing Committee is working closely with the Ministry of Foreign Affairs and Trade as well as other local authorities to make your entry into the country as smooth as possible. Please note that the attached Border Crossing Sheet needs to be filled out and sent back to the Head of the OC ([David.szanto@musz.hu](mailto:David.szanto@musz.hu)) no later than **27 September 2021**. We will keep you updated with the regulations of the Hungarian Government regarding entry into Hungary and the rules of participating at sports events.

### VISA

All visitors to Hungary should have a valid visa for their entry and stay in the country. The Hungarian Swimming Association will do its utmost to facilitate an entry visa to Hungary for all participants of the World Cup who have completed their registration in the FINA GMS by the registration deadline. Please make sure that the visa fields are completed correctly in the GMS with the city and country where you will apply for the visa.
