I have the pleasure to send you the following information concerning the organisation of the ***FINA Coaches Certification Course –Coach Level (L2)*** scheduled to be held in Tirana, Albania (ALB), from 18th to 22nd May 2022.

Please note the following information related to the FINA Coaches Certification Programme and the coach's certification pathway:

Eligibility

- The FINA Coaches Certification Courses –Coach Level (L2) are open to all the National Federations who have active coaches requiring more in-depth training at an intermediate level.
- They are designed for those candidates that have completed the FINA Coaches Certification Course – Assistant Level (L1) or an equivalent coaching course recognized by FINA, preparing them for coaching duties in swimming.
- Participants must be at least 18 years old at the start of the FINA Coaches Certification Programme.

Registration

- Each FINA Coaches Certification Course requires a minimum of 10 and may have a maximum of 30 participants.
- As per the [FINA Coaches Certification Pathway](#) (page 7), candidates must be registered through the FINA GMS by the established deadline and their profiles must include the following information: personal data, photo, passport/National ID copy and the candidate's personal email address. Any application without all the above-mentioned information will be rejected.
