Entries

Every FINA National Federation is allowed to compete. All Federations participating in the competitions of the World Series must be registered by their National Federation in the FINA GMS in accordance with the deadlines.

Each country shall be entitled to enter one Technical Solo, one Free Solo, one Technical Duet, one Free Duet, one Technical Mixed Duet, one Free Mixed Duet, one Technical Team, one Free Team and one Free Combination and one Highlight Routine.

A female competitor may compete in a maximum of eight (8) events and shall not compete in both Duet and Mixed Duets.

For World Series only, it is possible to have up to two (2) male swimmers as part of the team in the Highlight and Free Combination events.

Visa

The Local Organising Committee will facilitate an entry visa to (Athens, Greece) by providing the official Letter of Invitation for all participants of the World Series Super Final who have successfully requested one and completed their registration in the FINA GMS by the visa deadline.

Please make sure that the visa mandatory fields (i.e. personal data and contacts, scan of the valid passport) are completed correctly and up to date in the FINA GMS. Please note, that the passport expiry date must be no earlier than (01/12/2022).

The Local Organising Committee will issue the Letter of Invitation, which will be sent to the email address indicated within the GMS registration.

All judges must be announced to the FINA Office. The Office will then register them in the GMS. If a Federation wishes to nominate two (2) judges, they must announce the first and then the second judge. The second judge will only be accepted if there are enough vacancies.

All judges must be on the FINA 2022 List and must have passed the Online Exam in October 2021 to apply for a judging position at this competition.

All judges will be required to wear black trousers and black shoes. The polo shirts will be given by the Organising Committee.

All requests must be received at least forty-eight (48) hours prior to the registration deadline

Sport Presentation

Every participation National Federation is required to inform the LOC of the following information*:

- * Short presentation of the athletes and the coach
- * Explain the choice of music and its meaning to the athlete(s)
- * Solo, duet or team's best achievements
- * Solo, duet or team's goals for this event and goals for the future
- * For solo and duet: give some information about the athletes (studies, main interests)
- * Please provide at least one fun fact about the swimmers, the team and/or the coach.

This information will be used by the commentators after the routines and will help the audience to connect with the athletes.

Please note that by participating in this FINA Event, every National Federation warrants that it has cleared any copyright related to the music used for the routines of its athlete(s) and/or team(s) and that it will indemnify FINA in the event any claim is filed against FINA in respect of any breach of such copyrights.

Gala Show

Each Federation attending the event must come prepared with at least one Exhibition Gala Show that is different from all competition routines presented. A routine with no rules; make up welcome; accessories welcome.

These are different routines than the competition routines and it is providing the athletes with a moment to shine and showcase their personalities.

COVID-19 related Information

Traveling between Greece and foreign countries is possible, with different conditions depending on the origin country.

- For fully vaccinated persons no PCR or rapid is needed.
- For non-vaccinated persons a 72 hour PCR test or a 48 hours antigen test is needed.

Valid vaccines in Greece are:

- Pfizer/BioNTech, Moderna, AstraZeneca, Johnson& Johnson

PCR tests will be organised by the OC during the event upon request. You must count 70€ for each test.
