## V. TRAVEL INFORMATION

Please book ALL flights to the **Calgary International Airport (YYC)**.

All members must travel to Calgary. The organizing committee will provide shuttles from the airport to the hotel upon your arrival and departure.

### COVID TRAVEL RESTRICTIONS

Travellers are eligible to enter or return to Canada if they qualify as a fully vaccinated traveler.

#### To qualify as a fully vaccinated traveller to Canada, you must:

- have received at least 2 doses of a vaccine accepted for travel, a mix of 2 accepted vaccines
  - or at least 1 dose of the Janssen/Johnson & Johnson vaccine
- have received your second dose at least 14 calendar days before you enter Canada
  - Example: if your second dose was anytime on **Thursday, July 1**, then **Thursday, July 15** would be the first day that you meet the 14 day condition
- have no signs or symptoms of COVID-19
- [follow pre-entry testing and entry requirements](#)
  - [upload proof of vaccination in ArriveCAN](#)
  - complete your ArriveCAN submission and have ArriveCAN receipt with letter I, V, or A beside your name
  - complete arrival test if selected

#### To enter or return to Canada as a fully vaccinated traveller, you must follow all of these requirements.

Have the following items with you for assessment by a government official at the border (land border crossings do not provide WiFi for travellers):

- [Results of your professionally administered or observed pre-entry test](#)
- [ArriveCAN receipt with letter I or, V, or A beside the vaccinated traveller's name](#)
- [Proof of vaccination that was uploaded into ArriveCAN \(original or paper copy\)](#)
- [Have a quarantine plan](#)
- Travel document entered in ArriveCAN (e.g. passport)

### VISA INFORMATION

Citizens of certain countries and territories need a visa to visit or transit Canada. Please note: If you hold a passport other than Canadian or you are stateless, you need a visa to visit or transit in Canada.

Canada has introduced a requirement for countries that previously did not require a visa to enter Canada. This is called an eTA (electronic travel authorization).

Visa assistance will be provided to those National Federations that have completed the registration forms by the specified registration deadline. This includes the submission of all mandatory data such as photo and an electronic scan of each person's passport.

## VI. PARTICIPANT COSTS

### Rooms

Any COVID testing related to travel is to be covered by the participating federations.

\*A **50% deposit** must be placed while submitting the **Final Entry Form on Friday, May 6<sup>th</sup>**.

Any cancellations after **Thursday, May 26<sup>th</sup>** (two weeks before) are subject to a cancellation fee of \$100.00/person.

Any cancellations after **Thursday, June 2<sup>nd</sup>** (one week before) are subject to pay their first two days of participation costs.

All participants (athletes, coaches, medical and/or managers) not staying at the host hotel will be subject to a \$300 USD/person competition fee, to be paid by the final entry deadline of **Friday, May 6<sup>th</sup>**.

## VIII. COMPETITION FORMAT

### Individual events

The FINA Diving Grand Prix 2022 will be run according to the tournament format.

### Preliminaries

The top 12 divers advance to the Semi-Finals (Groups A and B).

### Semi-Finals

- ❖ Group A 12 – 10 – 8 – 6 – 4 – 2
- ❖ Group B 11 – 9 – 7 – 5 – 3 – 1

### Finals

The top 3 divers from Groups A and B advance to the Finals (total of 6 divers in Final).

### Replacement of injured diver

In the case of an injury following the Preliminary competition, the next qualified diver will take the place.

In the case of an injury following the Semi A or Semi B, the next qualified diver of the same Semi-final will take the place.

## XI. GRAND PRIX COMPETITION RULES

### Conditions of Entry

- ❖ The FINA Diving Grand Prix (“DGP”) shall be open to all FINA affiliated Federations.
- ❖ Entries of divers in the FINA Diving Grand Prix shall be accepted only from the Federations, Members of FINA.
- ❖ Divers age 12 and 13 years on December 31st of the same year shall be eligible to participate (as per age group C).
- ❖ Each host may invite additional divers to compete in the events as they deem appropriate.
- ❖ The maximum number of divers who can participate in an individual DGP event is four (4).
- ❖ Any Federation with more than two divers in an event may be permitted to advance to the semi-finals only the top two (2) performers in that event.
- ❖ The Host Federation may enter two (2) teams in the direct final of a synchro event but only the best team may proceed to the podium.
- ❖ No additional divers or teams may participate in a DGP meet, other than those specified in the Rules & Regulations. There will be no opportunity for exhibition places.

### Rules

- ❖ All events shall be conducted in accordance with the FINA Rules, which can be found on the FINA Website ([www.fina.org](http://www.fina.org) – about FINA – Rules).
- ❖ The Organising Federation shall publish the conditions of the event by advising the FINA Office in Lausanne (SUI) at least two (2) months prior to the commencement of the competition.

### Judges

- ❖ A Federation taking part in a FINA DGP meet with a team of four (4) divers or more should bring a judge.
- ❖ The judge might, however, also serve as a coach provided that this is not for an event where he/she is judging.
- ❖ A Federation that does not bring a judge will be fined 250 Swiss Francs payable to FINA.

## XII. ORGANISERS SPECIAL ARRANGEMENTS

### Conditions of entry

- ❖ Teams can enter maximum of 4 divers who can participate in an individual events, with only the top-two being eligible to advance.

### Medical and Lifeguards

- ❖ Lifeguards will be on duty at all training/competition sessions and will act as the first responders.
- ❖ A medical clinic is situated at the competition venue that offers service on a pay per use basis

- ❖ A physician will be available to participants by contacting the organizing committee.
- ❖ Physio tables will be available for visiting countries to use at both the competition venue and host hotel.
