





## O4 Rules (cont'd)

Competition Format	The Female Solo Free, Duet Free and Team Free events shall be held with preliminaries and finals. The routines that are ranked 1st – 12th after the preliminary round shall qualify for finals.
	The Male Solo Free, Male Solo Technical, Female Solo Technical, Duet Technical, Team Technical, Mixed Duet Technical, Mixed Duet Free, and Highlight routine events will be straight finals.
	The Free Combination event will include a preliminary round if there are more than twelve (12) entries.
Eligibility Age	<b>Junior.</b> 15-18 years of age on December 31, 2022 (born in 2004, 2005, 2006, 2007)
Time Limits	According to FINA Rules (AS 14).
Draws	Will be held at Team Leaders Meeting on August 22, according to FINA rules (AS 13.7).

#### 07 Technical Officials

Eligibility	Each participating Federation may nominate a maximum of two (2) judges qualified in category G or A from the FINA list.
	Neutral FINA judges should ask their Federation to nominate them to the FINA office.
	Nominated judges shall be approved by the FINA TASC, who reserves the right to select only one (1) judge per federation depending on the number of entries.
	National Federations will be responsible for all their judges' expenses. Neutral judges are responsible for their own expenses (unless otherwise arranged with their own federation).
	Judges cannot be assured of a spot on every event, but Federations may be assured that each judge will be seated enough times to receive a full evaluation by a FINA evaluator.
	Names of judges should be sent to artisticswimming@fina. org for nomination and once approved, the National Federation is responsible to finalize the registration in GMS.
Practice Judges	By application to the FINA Office at least 60 days before the start of the event.
	The TASC and the OC reserve the right not to accept practice judges if the COVID protocols make it difficult to do so.



#### 08 COVID-19 Protocols & Testing

All accredited competition participants, including all athletes and all personnel (coach, staff, athlete and judges) will be required to take a COVID-19 PCR test before scheduled arrival into Canada.

As of June 10, 2022, all international visitors must be fully vaccinated to enter Canada.

Please understand travel requirements may change before August. It is each person's responsibility to verify current travel requirements.

More information about testing and safety protocols will be included in our **Safety Playbooks**, which will be updated as the situation evolves.

#### 09 Music

All music files (routine music + gala music + National Anthem) must be submitted electronically **before July 29, 2022**. A Dropbox File Request will be sent by the OC the the person in charge of music for each Federation, as indicated in the Preliminary Entry Form.

File must be labeled with the following information, all separated by underscores, with no blank spaces.

Federations must also have in their possession a digital copy of their music on USB sticks for use as backup if necessary.

#### 10 Visa Information

Upon request through the FINA GMS, Canada Artistic Swimming will provide Visa assistance by issuing an invitation letter.

Please note that in the current context, we expect that issuing visas will take much longer than in the past and we urge you to begin this process as early as possible, but at least 90 days before the date of the competition, to avoid possible travel problems due to delays.

We therefore invite you to complete all necessary visa information in the FINA GMS by May 20, 2022.

### Electronic Travel Authorization (eTA)

An Electronic Travel Authorization (eTA) is an entry requirement for visa-exempt foreign nationals travelling to Canada by air. An eTA is electronically linked to a traveller's passport. It is valid for up to five years or until the passport expires, whichever comes first.

#### 12 Exhibition Gala

On Saturday, August 27, we will present an Exhibition Gala. ALL delegations must be prepared participate in this final gala as it is one of the main ways to develop and promote our sport. Solo, duet, trio, accessories, improvisations, make up - everything is allowed to make this Exhibition Gala a spectacular show to finish our week together.

Each federation attending the event should plan and come prepared with one Exhibition Gala Show routine which is different from the competition routines. We ask that all federations fill out the Gala Routine Information Form before July 15, 2020, to help us plan the event.

#### 13 Transportation

All teams and persons accommodated at the official hotels will be provided with all necessary transportation free of charge, including airport pickup and dropoffs as well as regular daily shuttles.



#### 14 Accommodation

Accommodation may be booked on a first-come, first-served basis. Please use the online Preliminary Accommodation Entry to reserve your preferred hotel early.

Prices include hotel accommodations, event entry fees, transportation and meals during the teams stay. Hotel accommodations will offer two double/queen beds or one king. Three meals a day beginning with dinner on your check-in day (pending arrival time) and ending with breakfast on your check-out day (pending your departure time). All fees are USD.

EXAMPLE: Check-in on August 20 and check-out on August 28 reserving one double room with two people. Total cost would be 2 (people) X \$185 (per person/per night) X 8 (nights) = \$2.960.

Please note that rooms in triple and quad occupancy only have two double/queen beds, which have to be shared by occupants.
