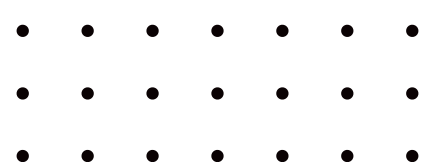

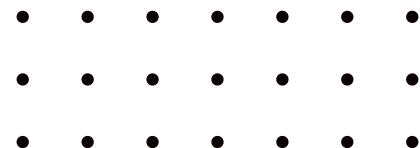

REGISTRATION AND ENTRY PROCESS

All nominations and sport entries shall be made electronically via the FINA General Management System (GMS) via the link <https://data.fina.org> **by the deadline of October 19th, 23.59 GMT.**

The registration for the 2022 World Junior High Diving Invitational should also be done through the FINA GMS. Please nominate your athletes and team officials attending this competition and submit their registration. Contrary to Diving, you do not need to complete sport entries for them, they will automatically be entered in the correct age group. However, please make sure that you have ticked the discipline of High Diving in their nomination, or both disciplines if they attend Diving and High Diving

Please be reminded that transportation from the airport will only be coordinated if the flight information is entered correctly and on time in the GMS **by November 1st.**

VISA INFORMATION

Citizens of certain countries and territories need a visa to visit or transit Canada. Please note: If you hold a passport other than Canadian or you are stateless, you need a visa to visit or transit in Canada. Canada has introduced a requirement for countries that previously did not require a visa to enter Canada. This is called an eTA (electronic travel authorization). Upon request through the FINA GMS, Diving Plongeon Canada will provide visa assistance by issuing an invitation letter. Please note that in the current context, we expect that issuing visas will take much longer than in the past and we urge you to begin this process as early as possible to avoid possible travel problems due to delays.

We therefore invite you to complete all necessary visa information in the FINA GMS as soon as possible and before October 1st.

CANADA VACCINE MANDATE

AIRPORT INFORMATION

All arrivals and departures must be done to and from Montreal-Trudeau International Airport (**YUL**). The LOC will have an information booth in the terminal.

Local transportation to and from the airport will be organized for all participants that have entered their travel information in the GMS before November 1st.

WEATHER IN MONTREAL

The temperature in Montreal in November and December will be **COLD**. Even though transportation between the facility and the hotel will be organized by the host committee, we strongly suggest that all participants come prepared for :

- Temperatures between 2°C and -10°C
- Snow and ice

TECHNICAL OFFICIALS

Each National Federation may nominate, at its own expense, one (1) or two (2) FINA A-judges or G-judges, whether the federation is entering divers or not. National Federations entering four (4) or more divers must provide at least one (1) judge. The judges must be included in the FINA Diving Judges List 2022 (available here <https://www.fina.org/diving/officials>).

Please return the Judges Nomination Form as soon as possible, but no later than October 1st, 2022 to diving@fina.org and montreal2022@diving.ca

Following the approval by FINA, the registration has to be completed in the FINA GMS **by October 19th, 2022.**

No judge may work as a coach during the 24th FINA World Junior Diving Championships 2022, however, the individual may hold any other position within their team.

DOPING

Doping control procedures will be in place at the competition.

Divers are responsible for bringing government-issued photo ID (or a high-resolution copy) in case they are selected for doping control. Divers are also responsible for any medication/supplement they are taking. Athletes under 18 must have a chaperone from their team to accompany them during their test.

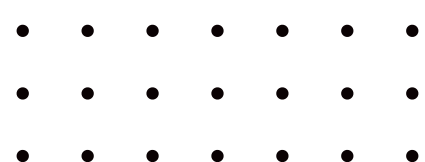
Please note that some of the high diving training sessions from Nov 29th to Dec 2nd will be at

COVID-19 PROTOCOLS & TESTING

All accredited competition participants, including all athletes and all personnel (coach, staff, athlete and judges) will be required to take a **COVID-19 PCR** test no earlier than than 72 hours before scheduled departure to Canada, at their own cost. Results must be sent to montreal2022@diving.ca prior to your arrival to be able to get your accreditation. Testing can be arranged prior to departure with the LOC and will be charged back to participants.

As of August 30th, 2022, **all international visitors must be fully vaccinated to enter Canada.** Please understand travel requirements may change before November. It is each person's responsibility to verify the **current travel requirements.**

All participants and visitor will be required to fill **ARRIVECAN** phone app prior 0-48hrs prior to their first flight to Canada.

MEDICAL SERVICES

On-site medical services will be available to all participants from November 24 to December 4. In case of an emergency, the EMS will decide which hospital the patient will be transferred to depending on the type of injury or illness. More information will be provided in a future communication.
