The Centre sportif du Parc olympique has been fully renovated and is considered to be one of the premiere diving facilities in the world. Built for the 1976 Summer Games, the Centre sportif regularly hosted the FINA Diving Grand Prix from 2007 to 2012 and the Diving World Series since 2018. The complex features 1m, 3m, 5m, 7.5m, 10m, 12m, 15m, 18m, and 20m platforms, and numerous 1m and 3m springboards. The venue also possesses a world-class dry-land training areas with padded floors, dry boards, trampolines, and resistance training equipment.

SPECTATORS AND TICKETING

All diving fans are invited to attend preliminary sessions on a COMPLIMENTARY basis and do NOT require tickets. Tickets are required for FINALS ONLY.

Event merchandise will be available at the Diving Canada boutique located at the main entrance of the Sports Center. Due to the limited quantity, all items can be purchased using a **credit card** on a first come first served basis. The boutique will be opened on competition days.



MEDICAL SERVICES and SANITARY PROTOCOLS

UPDATE | COVID-19 PROTOCOLS & REMOVAL OF TESTING

Based on the recent guidelines and announcements from the government in Canada and the province of Québec, all accredited competition participants, including all athletes and all personnel (coach, staff, athlete and judges) **will NOT be required to take any type of COVID test prior to arriving to Canada.**

For delegations who need it, testing can be arranged prior to departure with the LOC and will be charged back to participants.

ON-SITE MEDICAL SERVICES

On-site medical services will be available to all participants from November 24th to December 4th.

Physicians

There will be a physician available everyday from November 24th until December 4th from 8:00AM to 4:00PM.

Physiotherapy

Physiotherapy will be available poolside on a complimentary basis every other day from November 24th until December 4th. The schedule will alternate between morning and evening session. It will be possible to make an appointment, or to walk-up to the service provider.

Massage therapy

Complimentary certified sport massage therapists will be available during the competition days from 10:00AM to 6:00PM.

Lifeguards and EMS services

Lifeguards will be onsite at the competition venue during training and competition to provide first aid during training and competition. They are responsible to respond to all emergencies on the pool deck. They will initiate the EMS services procedures in place by the Olympic pool when needed. In case of an emergency, the EMS will decide which hospital the patient will be transferred to depending on the type of injury or illness.

Treatment tables

Treatment tables will be available at the pool for teams to use. At the hotels a treatment room with tables will be made available to the teams.



DOPING CONTROL

Doping control will be taking place throughout the competition. Event accreditations do **NOT** count as official identification. Please have your athlete bring proper government issued identification to the pool on their competition days. Divers are also responsible for any medication/supplement they are taking.

Athletes under 18 must have a chaperone from their team to accompany them during their test.

TECHNICAL DETAILS

JUDGES

Scoring: For the individual competitions, scoring will be in accordance with FINA Diving Rules D7.5. For the synchronized and mixed synchro competitions there shall be 7 judges, comprising 4 execution judges and 5 synchronization judges. The secretaries shall accept the “execution awards” and shall cancel the highest and lowest “synchronization awards” and shall then calculate the score in accordance with FINA Diving Rule D7.7.

DIVING - RULES & FORMAT

The 24th FINA World Junior Diving Championships 2022 will be conducted under FINA Rules Click [HERE](#), except for the Team Event. The below format will take place and the new rules will become into effect as of 2023.


Competition Format - Mixed Team Event

1. The team consists of at least one female and one male diver but no more than four (4) divers.
2. In the team there must be at least 1 diver from B group.
3. 6 dives are performed in total and must include all 6 groups.
4. Event includes 2 individual dives from 3m: one performed by a male diver and one by a female diver.
5. The dives are performed without DD limit.
6. Event includes 2 individual dives from 5, 7.5 or 10 meter platform height: one performed by a male diver and one by a female diver.
7. The dives are performed without DD limit.
8. Event includes 2 mixed synchronised dives: one performed from 3m springboard and one from 5 or 10 meter platform height.
9. The dives are performed without DD limit.

Fun "RIP" Contest (during the opening ceremony)

Each nation will be asked to nominate ONE (1) diver who will represent them in a RIP contest that will happen during the Opening Ceremony on November 27th. This representative will also be the flag bearer for his/her nation for the ceremony. There will ONLY be a FINAL round. ONE (1) dive will be performed from the 10m platform and the D.D. will count.

Dive Sheet and divers name/bio must be submitted by the end of the technical meeting.

NOTE: All the withdrawal and correction forms must first be approved by the referee and then handed to the Secretariat of the competition.


PARTICIPANT ZONES

Only divers/coaches that are presently competing will be allowed in the field of play. A dedicated coaching area will be provided for team officials to coach their divers.

Divers and team officials not presently competing may remain on pool deck in the designated seating areas, in the dry-land training area or in the designated zones that are outside of the pool deck.

The best seating area for your athletes when not competing and/or training is located on the upper level in the stands. As we want to ensure a smooth competition, we thank you in advance to be respectful in implementing this with your divers.

AIRPORT TRANSPORTATION

The LOC will organize airport pick-ups/drop-offs for all participants that have entered their flight information in the GMS. Please look for our kiosk booth in the local and international terminal.

LOCAL TRANSPORTATION

As an effort to host a more environmentally friendly event, all participants will receive a 14-days metro pass at the same time as their accreditation. We **STRONGLY** suggest that participants keep it in their accreditation sleeve in order to not lose it. Losing a metro pass may encounter some extra charges to get a new one.

Going from the Hotel Royal Versailles to the Olympic Park

VIA METRO

Get out of the hotel by the main entrance.

You will need to cross the street and then you will see the metro station right there.

Get on at **RADISSON** station (*going towards ANGRIGNON*).

Stay on the metro for (4) stops and then exit at **VIAU** station.

Then it will be a short 5 minutes outdoor walk to the "Centre Sportif" entrance.

Total trip is approximately **15-20 minutes**.

Going from the Hotel Universel to the Olympic Park

VIA WALKING


Get out of the hotel by the main entrance.

Cross the street and stay on Sherbrooke Street.

Keep walking approximately 500M until you see the CF Montreal football field on your left side.

Go down the stairs and keep your left towards the Sport Center entrance.

Total trip is approximately **10 minutes**.



MONTREAL METRO MAP




**MAIN ENTRANCE
