

World Aquatics Diving Recognised Events - Application Form 2023-2024

World Aquatics believes in the importance of supporting International Events to develop and educate athletes, judges, officials and volunteers worldwide while also contributing to the exposure of the sport. World Aquatics is introducing a *Recognised Events* model to help the community grow and achieve common goals. All Member Organisations can apply for an Event hosted within their region to be a *World Aquatics Recognised Event*.

The following criteria would need to be demonstrated:

- ✓ The Event must respect the World Aquatics Rules
- ✓ The Olympic events need to be on the programme (anything additional is up to the Organiser)
 - Women and Men 3m Springboard and 10m Platform Individual events
 - Women and Men 3m Springboard and 10m Platform Synchronised events
- ✓ The Event should be held over a minimum of three days
- ✓ There should be no limit on how many divers a National Federation can register but only the top 2 best scores can progress to the individual finals and only 1 synchronised team can be on the podium from the respective National Federation
- ✓ The Organiser must have a minimum of 4 National Federations in attendance
- ✓ The Event shall be judged by World Aquatics Certified A or G judges (at the cost of NFs or Organiser)
- ✓ There must be 1 World Aquatics Technical Diving Delegate in attendance. The World Aquatics Technical Delegate shall be appointed by World Aquatics and should come from outside the host continent. Their role is to undertake judges' evaluations and ensure the World Aquatics rules are applied. This request shall be addressed to the World Aquatics Office (marie-eve.marleau@worldaquatics.com) at least 60 days prior to the event. The Organiser shall cover the following costs:
 - Flights in Economy class
 - Full board accommodation (room and 3 meals per day)
 - Per diem of USD 150.00 per day
- ✓ The Organiser must provide the basic level of safety and medical cover for the whole duration
- ✓ The Prize Money is at the discretion of the host, not mandatory
- ✓ The Organiser must provide an Information Bulletin to World Aquatics at least 60 days prior to the Event. (a template will be shared by World Aquatics)
- ✓ The Organiser must send official results in the correct format to the World Aquatics Office at results@fina.org immediately after the conclusion of the Event
- ✓ The Organiser must pay an event fee to World Aquatics of USD 500.00

If the Event is recognised by World Aquatics, the LOC will be receiving:

- The official *World Aquatics Recognised Event* logo
- Inclusion on World Aquatics International Events Calendar
- The publishing of the Event's results on World Aquatics website

- In order for World Aquatics to endorse results at approved competitions, the National Federation / Organiser must send the official results to the World Aquatics Office at results@fina.org IMMEDIATELY AFTER THE CONCLUSION OF THE COMPETITION.
- **ONLY Diving XML files and ODF (Olympic Data Feed) messages will be accepted.** The electronic file(s) must be sent together with the corresponding **PDF** file(s).
- **World Aquatics will not accept any results sent in word, excel or solely PDF format.** Results sent in this format will not be considered for official World Aquatics results.
- It is the responsibility of the National Federation / Organiser to check the correctness of the results data and the accuracy of the files. Files containing errors will not be taken into account for their import into the World Aquatics database and the results from the related competition will consequently not be available for selection as Qualifying Results.
- Please check on a regular basis your athletes' results and immediately report to results@fina.org for any errors.
