

1. PRESIDENT'S MESSAGE World Aquatics Festival 2023

It is with great pleasure that I get to welcome the world's best artistic swimmers, open water swimmers, beach water polo players and their respective National Federations to the Egypt Aquatics Festival.

Taking place at the breath-taking Somabay beach resort on Egypt's Red Sea coast from 8-15 May 2023, this multi-aquatic event is set to elevate our events and profile of our athletes to new heights and follows in the success of our inaugural Aquatics Festival that ran in parallel with the World Swimming Championships (25m) in 2021.



The Egypt Aquatics Festival gets underway with the opening event of the World Aquatics Open Water Swimming World Cup 2023 season from 8-9 May, as the open water swimming elite compete in the men's and women's 10km individual and 4x1500m relay events. Reserved for the best open water swimmers in the world, this prestigious event series will see more than 300 athletes from over 50 countries compete in one of our most demanding and exciting competitions.

With beach water polo making its debut at the ANOC World Beach Games Bali 2023 later this year, the Egypt Aquatics Festival is the final tournament for men's and women's national teams to qualify for the multi-sport event. In Somabay, the top three teams from both the men's and women's beach water polo tournaments will earn the final spots for Bali 2023 event, which runs from 5-12 August 2023.

Completing the elite competitions at the Egypt Aquatics Festival will be the third stop of the World Aquatics Artistic Swimming World Cup 2023 which will run alongside the beach water polo tournament from 13-15 May. I am sure our Somabay hosts will provide athletes and spectators with great entertainment and hospitality.

I would like to thank the Egyptian Swimming Federation and Somabay who, along with the support of the Local Organising Committee, local authorities, volunteers, international media, and sponsors, have made this event a reality. I am sure that Egypt Aquatics Festival will represent another milestone in our history of hosting world class events for our athletes. We are deeply grateful to all our hosts and know that aquatics athletes feel the same way.

2. INTRODUCTION

Somabay, Hurghada, Egypt

Somabay is a prime touristic destination in Egypt, ideally situated on the eastern shores of Egypt on the Red Sea coast just 20 minutes by car from Hurghada International Airport. The ten million square meters, self-contained community of Somabay is surrounded with three sides of the sea. Weather Conditions

Somabay's Red Sea waters are home to pristine sandy beaches and refreshing crystal clear water.

<u>Weather Temperature:</u> May is considered a tropical month in Somabay with temperature within the range of an average low of 21°C (69.8°F) and an average high of 31°C (87.8°F).

<u>Water Temperature:</u> Average temperature in Red Sea in Somabay in May is 25.1°C. This temperature range is recognized as the most optimal for prolonged bathing. Minimum

The water temperature in Somabay in May is 23.0°C, maximum 28.0°C. In recent years, at the beginning of the month, the temperature value here is at around 24°C, and by the end of the month the water warms up to 25.5°C.

 $\underline{\text{Water Conditions:}}$ Due to the sunny, warm weather, water conditions during this period of the year are steady and clear with a low current.

9. DECLARATION FORMS

As part of our ongoing efforts to improve our services and streamline our operations, we have implemented a new system that will make it easier and more efficient for World Aquatics Members to submit Declaration Forms. The Declaration Forms have been revised and there is now one version for Athletes and Members. The revised Declaration Forms are also valid for the lifetime of the Athlete and Member with the possibility of withdrawal at any time.

As of the March 1st, 2023, Declaration Forms are to be submitted through the World Aquatics GMS. Please find the details of this updated process in the following pages.

1) Download Declaration Form

A blank PDF Declaration Form is available for download on the World Aquatics website.

Declaration Forms with personal information pre-filled are available for download on the GMS through the following options:

1.1 Download Declaration Form button - A Download Declaration Form button Is located on the General tab of an Athlete/Member's profile under the Declaration Form section. By clicking this, a single Declaration Form with that Athlete/Member's personal Information completed will be downloaded.

1.2 Reports - Under the Reports drop down menu found in both the People and Nomination modules, the option to Download Declaration Forms is available. It is important to note that using this option will download Declaration Forms only for Athlete/Members who have not uploaded a Declaration Form to their profile (see point three below). This option will download Declaration Forms for Athlete/Members within the context of the filters applied at the time of selection. There is a limit of 100 Declaration Forms that can be downloaded at a single time through the Reports function.

2) Sign Declaration Form

If the Athlete/Member agrees to the terms and conditions set forth in the Declaration Form, the Athlete/Member should then sign and date the Athlete/Member Stakeholder section.

If an Athlete/Member is of minority age, an additional signature from their parent/legal guardian Is required.

3) Upload Declaration Form

The duly signed Declaration Form should be uploaded in the Athlete/Member's GMS profile. Signed Declaration Forms can be uploaded by dragging-and-dropping a file to the upload box or by clicking on the upload box itself to select a file.

Files are accepted in JPG, PNG, and PDF formats.



4) Check status of Declaration Form

4.1 Filter - Using the <Declaration Form> filter found at the top of the People and Nomination modules, it will be possible to filter by Athlete/Members with locked (approved by World Aquatics), unlocked (submitted) or missing Declaration Forms.

4.2 Reports - In the Registration Summary by event (Complete Report) excel report In the Nominations module, the Declaration Form column will Indicate whether an individual has an approved Declaration Form or not.

Important points to note:

- An approved Declaration Form is valid for the lifetime of the Athlete/Member with the possibility of withdrawal at any time. If you wish to withdraw, please contact gms@worldaquatics.com.
- A signed Declaration Form is to be uploaded to the GMS and approved by World Aquatics prior to collection of accreditation badges. Without a signed Declaration Form, accreditation will not be provided and participation at the World Aquatics events will not be allowed.
- There Is one version of the Declaration Form for Athletes/Members.

E-PARTICIPATION

Entries will be accepted only from National World Aquatics Member Federations which must also register a coach for each respective swimmer. A coach can be responsible for up to two (2) swimmers only. The coach is responsible for representing his/her swimmers at the Technical Meeting, and feeding the swimmer during the event. The World Aquatics Technical Delegate together with the Chief Referee will accept entries and register only swimmers accompanied by the respective coach who is in charge of swimmer recognition during the race. A swimmer without a coach present will not be allowed to start the race. Each National Federation that has entered one or more swimmers in an Event must also have at least one representative (e.g. team leader, coach) present.
