#### WEATHER IN FT. LAUDERDALE IN LATE MAY

Weather in Fort Lauderdale in late May is generally sunny and temperate, with an average temperature of 80°F (27°C).

Please plan accordingly for lots of sun and sporadic storms.

#### AIRPORT TRANSPORTATION

Transportation from Fort Lauderdale-Hollywood International Airport (FLL) to the HQ Hotel (Courtyard by Marriott Fort Lauderdale Beach) will be provided for arrival and departure to all federations who have booked their accommodations with the LOC and entered their flight details in the GMS.

Upon arrival to FLL, please head to baggage claim and look for an LOC member in a "USA Diving" shirt.

PLEASE KEEP IN MIND: The LOC will NOT arrange pick-ups/drop-offs for participants who have made their own accommodations.

#### WELCOME AND ACCREDITATION

Upon arrival to Fort Lauderdale, participants will be greeted by a USA Diving team member. Accreditations and welcome information will be distributed on arrival to the hotel if staying in the HQ Hotel.

If staying in alternate accommodations, participants MUST come to see an LOC team member at the Meet Operations Table at the venue and receive their accreditation prior to participating in any practice session on May 24th.

Accreditations will be required at all times in the training facility to pass security checkpoints and access necessary training areas. Accreditations will also indicate eligibility to receive meals, and must be shown in order to eat at both the hotel and at the pool.

As a reminder, meals will not be provided to participants who have opted to arrange their own accommodations.



















#### LOCAL TRANSPORTATION

The HQ Hotel is walking distance to the facility (.2km). The pool is visible from the hotel. Participants walk across the street from the hotel to the facility. Please see map below with a blue dotted line outlining the route to the pool.



For additional local transportation, there is a free electric vehicle service that provides transportation at no cost around the Downtown and Beach areas of Fort Lauderdale. 

# 7 MEDICAL SERVICES

#### ENTRY, SANITARY PROTOCOLS AND COVID-19 POLICY

As of May 12th, 2023, all non-U.S. citizen travelers are NO LONGER required to show proof of vaccination upon entry to the United States. Please see the announcement of the updated Order <u>HERE</u>

Please note, it is each traveler's responsibility to understand the entry guidelines for the United States, and USA Diving recommends reading the updated guidelines and procedures as described by the Department of State and the CDC.

#### **COVID-19 PROTOCOL**

All accredited competition participants (including athletes, coaches, staff, and judges) will not be required to take any type of Covid-19 Test prior to arriving in the United States and participating in the 2023 World Aquatics High Diving World Cup.

#### PHYSICIAN SUPPORT

Access to a physician will be available on a daily basis beginning May 24th, 2023 through the end of the event.

#### ATHLETIC TRAINING

Athletic training services will be offered to all participants on deck at the facility during each practice day and each competition day, from the time the pool opens until one hour after the last practice or event conclusion.

#### LIFEGUARDS, SAFETY DIVERS AND EMS SERVICES

Lifeguards will be on deck during all practice and competition to provide first aid. Lifeguards are our first responders, and responsible for primary response to any emergency, and they will initiate the EMS response plan. Trained safety divers will be in place for all practices designated 20M and above, as well as for the duration of the competition rounds. EMS will be on site In case of emergency, the EMS will decide which hospital the patient will be transferred to.
