### Fukuoka City Guide

Fukuoka City has played a vital role as a cross-cultural location between Japan and the continent for 2000 years, and has developed as an international and intercultural city. As a "Gateway to Asia", it boasts itself as one of the most accessible cities in Japan, with Fukuoka Airport named as one of the busiest airports in the country, Hakata Port with its regular routes to Busan, South Korea and Hakata Station as the gateway to the Kyushu region. In addition to the many restaurants serving Fukuoka's rich food culture among which include fresh fish, ramen, mizutaki, and motsunabe, such as the famous yatai (food stalls), the city core centred on the Hakata & Tenjin area is a compact region outfitted with modern urban functions and commercial facilities. For people keen on exploring traditional Fukuoka, "Hakata Old Town", a cultural hub close to Hakata Station with temples and shrines clustered together and where a historical festival is held yearly, or historical cultural heritages such as the Fukuoka Castle and Korokan Ruins near Ohori Park may be of interest. Additionally, enjoying Fukuoka's photogenic seaside from locations such as Shikanoshima Island, Kitazaki, or Futamigaura, is one of the highlights of visiting Fukuoka City. From Fukuoka City, it is possible to travel anywhere in the Kyushu region with ease using the Shinkansen bullet train or regular trains. In addition to many must-see spots such as onsen (hot springs) and locations showcasing the island's natural beauty, Kyushu is home to a diverse lineup of soul foods and local sake that travellers should definitely explore while they are in the area.

Hakata Old Town, Shikanoshima Island, Kitazaki Futamigaura, Fukuoka Tower, Ohori Park, Fukuoka Castle & Korokan Ruins, Fukuoka City Museum, Fukuoka Art Museum, Fukuoka Asian Art Museum, public art, Hakata Gion Yamakasa (a festival with approximately 800 years of history and registered as an UNESCO Intangible Cultural Heritage, held from 1–15 July anually)

Hakata Ramen (bowl of noodle in a rich, pork based soup), Mizutaki (hot pot dish made with chopped chickens and vegetables), Motsunabe (hot pot dish made with offal meat and vegetables), Hakata Udon (thick noodle made from wheat flour), Yakitori (glazed chicken skewers), Karashimentaiko (salted cod roe seasoned with red pepper)

Hakata Ori (high quality, silk woven goods), Hakata Dolls (unglazed porcelain dolls), Hakata Magemono (small containers made from cedar boards), Takatori Ware (pottery ware unique to the region).

### Shining water surface spreading to the world

From the future of aquatic sports to the future for the region, the medal design visualises the vision of Fukuoka World Aquatics Championships moving the hearts of many people and spreading out. The design of the front side of the medal is inspired by the water shadow phenomenon, which is when the water surface shines due to the reflection of light, and depicts the shape of Kyushu, centred on Fukuoka.

The rings of light on the surface of the water, represent the bright future that will emerge from aquatics sports and the connections between various peoples, and expresses the hope that this future will spread out starting with Fukuoka, then to Kyushu, and finally throughout the world.








### No. of gold medals:42 (men and women combined) Competition schedule:23 - 30 July

The world's top swimmers have gathered here for an intense competition to challenge their limits and break records. There are four styles: freestyle, backstroke, breaststroke, and butterfly. There are also individual medleys and relays where athletes swim all four swimming styles in a set order. The individual events are 50m, 100m, 200m, 400m, 800m, and 1500m for freestyle, 50m, 100m, 200m for the backstroke, breaststroke, and butterfly, and 200m and 400m for the individual medley. The team events are  $4 \times 100$ m and  $4 \times 200$ m for the freestyle relay,  $4 \times 100$ m for the medley relay,  $4 \times 100$ m for the mixed freestyle relay, and  $4 \times 100$ m for the mixed medley relay.

### Diving



### No. of gold medals:13 (men and women combined) Competition schedule:14 - 22 July

With springboard, platform, and synchronised diving events, athletes have their performances rated for accuracy, mid-air techniques and entry into the water. It takes less than two seconds from jumping to hitting the water, but the varied techniques they showcase in that brief amount of time determines their scores. Diving consists of Springboard (1 m, 3 m), Platform (10 m), Synchronised Springboard (3 m), Synchronised Platform (10 m), mixed events, and team event.

# Water Polo



### No. of gold medals:2 (men and women combined) Competition schedule:16 - 29 July

Two teams of seven players (including one goalkeeper) each compete in a pool court to score points by throwing the ball into the other team's goal. With its intense movements, this highly popular sport is sometimes called "underwater martial arts" due to the athletes fierce strength. The dynamism of the goals and movements of the athletes in and under the water are focal points. For Fukuoka 2023, the mens and womens tournaments will each have 16 teams participating.

Athletes from around the globe will compete in men and women's solos, women's duets, men and women's mixed duets, and in acrobatic routines and team competitions that include men. Their breath-taking performances are judged on beauty and technique. There are two types of programmes: technical and free, in which athletes perform five predetermined elements to music that lasts about two minutes and thirty seconds for technical routines, and perform a number of free elements predetermined by event that combine acrobatic performances with free movements to music that lasts about three minutes for free routines.

# High Diving



### No. of gold medals:2 (men and women combined) Competition schedule: 25 - 27 July

First introduced as an official discipline for the World Aquatics Championships at Barcelona 2013, it is said that the sport originated with Hawaiian kings jumping off of cliffs in order to display their courage to their warriors. Women jump from a 20-metre-high platform and men from a 27-metre-high platform. It takes only three seconds before landing. Blink and you'll miss the action.

# Open Water Swimming



### No. of gold medals:5 (men and women combined) Competition schedule: 15, 16, 18, 20 July

Unlike swimming competitions in the pool, Open Water Swimming competitions take place over long distances in natural bodies of water such as the open ocean, rivers and lakes. The competition distances for Fukuoka 2023 are 5 km and 10 km as well as the 6km team relay (4x1500m). Affected by natural conditions, Open Water Swimming is a grueling discipline that requires knowledge and experience as well as technique.

- \*Zone 4 refers to press areas which include the press centre, press conference room, media tribune, and mixed zone. Photographers must wear an official photographer bib to access approved shooting positions. For more information on the photographer bib, check page 55 of the Media Guide.

# Loss of Accreditation Card

If you lose your Accreditation Card, it must be reported immediately to the nearest security personnel from the Organising Committee. A penalty fee may be charged for the replacement of lost Accreditation Cards.

# Non-Rights Holding Broadcasters

Non-rights holding broadcasters and ENGs are accredited as media. "Media accredited persons" are not permitted to bring any TV/video cameras into the venues, and have no filming rights inside the venues where an accreditation or ticket is required for access, including media tribune and press conference rooms. Any media accredited persons found filming within the venues will be liable to have their accreditation cancelled. Audio-only recording is permitted by media accredited persons within the venues. Furthermore, all such persons have no access rights to Zone 5 (for broadcasting seats including commentator positions and observer seats) or the IBC.



#### Visa Information

#### Step 1 Register required information in the GMS

All participants must register all required information in the World Aquatics GMS. Regardless of whether or not you need to apply for a visa, all participants must register in the World Aquatics GMS. Only participants in status "approved" will be provided with the visa assistance.

#### Step2 Check the Countries or Regions that require a visa to enter Japan

For the Olympics, a visa was not required if you had an AD card, but there is no such system for this year's Championships.







### 2. Photographer Bibs

All photographers must have an Accreditation Card (AD Card) and a photo bib to access the photo positions. Photographers not wearing AD Card and photo bibs will be denied access to the photo positions. Photographers are required to wear their photo bibs at all times while in the venues. Photo bibs are available in green for standard positions and blue for pool positions. For the green bibs, they will be distributed at the Accreditation Center along with the AD Cards. The pool position bibs (blue) will be distributed prior to the start of the day's competition upon request (limited number of bibs available). For more details, please attend the photo briefing that will be held for each discipline. Photo bibs for pool positions must be returned after use. Each photo bib has a serial number and must not be transferred to anyone else. If you transfer it to someone else, your AD registration will be revoked.













## Loss of Accreditation Card and Photo Bib

#### Accreditation Card

If your Accreditation Card is lost, it must be reported immediately to the nearest security personnel from the Organising Committee. A penalty fee may be charged for the reproduction of lost Accreditation Cards.

#### Photo Bib

Lost photo bibs must be immediately reported to the MPC or SPC Info Desk. Photographers are asked to keep their photo bibs in a safe place.

## 4. Photographer Access Zone

Photographers are allowed access to the following areas.

- MPC (Main Press Centre)
- SPC (Sub Press Centre)
- Press Conference Room
- Photo Position (photo bib must be worn)

#### MPC (Main Press Centre) & SPC (Sub Press Centre)

Photo operation staff will be on standby at the MPC and SPC during the competition period.

#### **Press Conference Room**

Photographers may shoot at the competition venues and at all press conference rooms. However, please ensure not to obstruct the reporters or broadcasters. Use of flash is prohibited during press conferences.

#### Media Tribune

Photographers may use the press seats if they are available. Media Tribune are not meant for photography.

#### Medal Ceremony

Pool photographers have priority at medal ceremonies. Venue photo managers will give priority to photographers from the same country as the athlete receiving medals.

## 5. Rules & Regulations for Photographers

#### **Rules Regarding Bibs & Photo Positions**

- Photo positions (marked with PHOTO signage) will be available and at each venue of the championships.
- There are two types of photo positions: standard positions and pool positions.
- To use the standard positions, photographers will need an AD Card and a green photo bib with "PHOTO" printed on it.
- To use the pool positions, photographers will need an AD Card and a light blue photo bib with "POOL PHOTO" printed on it.
- POOL PHOTO bibs will be distributed on first-come, first-serve basis at PHOTO desk in each venue in following schedule.
  - 2 hours prior to first competition of the day:
     Distribution to 1st photographers from each media / organization.
  - 1 hour prior to first competition of the day Distribution to 2nd photographer from each media / organization
- Please keep in mind that number of POOL PHOTO bibs in each venue is limited.
- POOL PHOTO bib will be distributed in exchange with photographer's green PHOTO bib.
- PHOTO desk will be located at press centre, or near FOP entrance at each venue.
- After usage, photographers MUST RETURN the POOL PHOTO bib at PHOTO desk.
- Details about POOL PHOTO bib will be presented during photo briefing.
- Most seats/places for photo shoots are available on a first-come, first-served basis; however, there will be few exceptions.
  - Depending on the venue and the event, the venue photo manager can reserve photo positions (seats/places) based on the World Aquatics' priority list.
  - Some photo positions will be available only with pre-booking on a request basis. Booking is available through the photo manager.
- Positions on the photo stands cannot be reserved (apart from the assigned agencies for operating the underwater cameras).
   Photo equipment left on the photo stands will be removed at the end of each session.
- Depending on the venue, photographers must wait in designated area in FOP during athletes entry then photographers may enter photo positions.
- Photographers should remain in photo position during competition and may only move during breaks in that competition. Moving during the competition is prohibited.
- Photo positions next to the FOP are sensitive areas.

  Unnecessary movement or noise from the photographer during

the competition may affect athletes' performances. Any distracting behavior may lead to the loss of the photo positions in the next and subsequent competitions.

#### Regulations

- Taking videos with any device is strictly prohibited.
- Devices generating their own Wi-Fi (Wi-Fi hotspots) networks are strictly prohibited. They will be deactivated in case of use.
- Mobile phones should be set at silent/vibration mode whenever in field of play area. Recording videos on the competition by your mobile phone is also strictly prohibited.
- In any photo position a strict 'NO BAG' policy applies. If there is a Bag, it will be removed from photo positions.
- While working, photographers are not allowed to use any tripod, ladder or flash (during the competitions). The flash may be used only at the victory ceremonies.
- Please consult the Photo Manager regarding usable photo areas during the official training sessions.
- Photographers are not allowed into the mixed zone where shooting is prohibited.
- Photographers should wear proper clothing at all times.
- Any breach of the regulations listed above would leave an immediate withdrawal of the accreditation.

#### Remote Cameras

- All remote-control cameras have to be approved by World Aquatics and 24 hours in advance.
- For use of items which transmits radio waves such as "pocket wizard", an application form must be submitted and approve by FUKUOKA OC.

- Remote camera will only be able to setup on catwalk in Marine Messe A. If you wish to setup a remote camera please consult with Photo Manager.
- Underwater cameras and usage of the catwalk are reserved to pool photographers and are subject to approval by World Aquatics.





#### PHOTO OPERATIONS

#### Special Request for Photographers

- Special care must be taken with photographic equipment for the safety of the athletes.
- Photographers must where appropriate clothing to shoot in the venue.
- Please be respectful to all parties (i.e. athletes, officials, HB, fellow media, volunteers and staffs) who will be working at the venue.
- Please make sure to return the POOL PHOTO bib at the PHOTO desk every single day. If there is a missing POOL PHOTO bib, it will cause one less photo position in FOP for the rest tournament

#### 6. Spectrum

All devices that use radio frequencies (e.g., wireless cameras, remote camera triggers, walkie-talkies, wireless microphones, etc.) must be authorized by the LOC in advance and some must be paid for. Even if a device has been permitted for independent use in Japan, prior authorization is still required. Devices that do not require pre-authorization include cell phones, key chains, wireless Bluetooth keyboards and mice, Wi-Fi access points and earphones. All equipment requiring authorization must receive radio frequency inspection at the "Spectrum Desk" before being brought into the competition venues. The LOC will attach an Authorization Sticker to the equipment that has passed the inspection.

For the authorization procedure all user need to fill out the 'Radio Frequency Application Form' with following 'Radio Frequency Guideline' and send the completed form to the LOC by e-mail: radio@2022fukuoka.com

# Security

Before entering the competition venues, everyone, including the media, must go through security check.

#### Security Check

At the entrance gate, we will check your AD card and baggage.

#### **Compliance Matters**

Only accredited media are permitted to enter the media zone.

Persons who have a problem with drugs and alcohol are not allowed to enter into the media zone.

Damage to or unauthorized use of property or signage is prohibited.

Language or behavior that violates or insults the human rights of participants, spectators, volunteers, etc. will not be tolerated.

Displaying banners, posters, and printed placards is prohibited.

Antagonistic slogans, sexism, racism, and religious discrimination are prohibited.

Promotion of religious or personal agendas is prohibited.





#### Prohibited Items

#### Swords and guns

• Firearms, ammunition, knives, other items in violation of the Act for Controlling the Possession of Firearms or Swords and Other Such Weapons

#### Items that could be used as a weapon

- Tools such as cutters, scissors, razors Hammers, wrenches, saws, screwdrivers, etc.
- Sharp instruments such as ice picks and awls Stick-shaped objects over 90cm that can be used as a weapon [Exceptions]
- Canes required for health reasons Permissible stick-shaped objects of 90 cm or longer such as umbrellas and selfie sticks

#### **Explosives**

• Explosives, gunpowder, smoke canisters, flares, fireworks, firecrackers, imitation bombs, ignition devices [Exceptions] • Matches and lighters for personal use

#### Poisons, drugs, and other harmful substances

- Items that may be in violation of the Poisonous and Deleterious Substances Control Law
- Narcotics, methamphetamines, and other controlled substances, or substances similar to these
- · Hydrogen fluoride and other toxic substances, chemicals, irritants and tear gas, paints and varnishes

#### Combustible materials

• Fuel, flammable liquid

#### Gas cylinders or replicas of gas cylinders

• Gas cylinders or similar items, fire extinguishers • Fire extinguisher and other compressed gas cylinders [Exceptions] • Portable oxygen cylinders for medical use

#### Medical supplies

• Liquid, aerosol, and gel chemicals 【Exceptions】 • Reasonable quantities of medicines for personal use

#### Wireless equipment

Unauthorized radio equipment, jamming devices, radio scanners, drones
 [Exceptions] • Cell phones, smart phones, tablet devices
 (The use of wireless routers or tethering functions on cell phones is prohibited in the venue)

#### Political, religious, or vulgar graphics, trademarks, etc.

 Advertising materials with content that violates religious, political, or public order and morality, ropes, placards, and other materials that may be used for demonstrations at the venue

#### Unauthorized flyers, pamphlets, and promotional materials

• Commercial objects that could be used for ambush marketing

#### Broadcast equipment and strobe lights

• Use prohibited in venue

#### Tripods, etc.

• Tripods [Exceptions] • Monopods

#### Items that interfere with the operations of the event or the progress of the competition

- Equipment that makes excessive noise, such as whistles, vuvuzelas, gas horns, and musical instruments,
- Paper to be used for confetti or confetti making, sporting goods, misters, water guns Note: Leaving the items on evacuation routes are prohibited.

The official currency of Japan is the Japanese Yen (JPY). The exchange rate for some major currencies is as follows:

1 US dollar (USD) = 139 yen.

1 euro (EUR) = 149 yen.

1000 Korean won (KRVV) = 105 yen.

10 Chinese yuan (CNY) = 190 yen.

For the current exchange rate, visit the website.

Except for some local markets and small shops, most stores accept all major credit

cards.

Currency exchange is available at most banks.

The following coins and banknotes are used in Japan:

Coins: 1 yen, 5 yen, 10 yen, 50 yen, 100 yen, 500 yen Banknotes: 1,000 yen, 2,000 yen, 5,000 yen, 10,000 yen

#### **Banks**

Most banks are open from 9 a.m. to 3 p.m. on weekdays and closed on weekends.

Money can be withdrawn from some ATMs using credit cards at any time.

Exchange rates differ by banks; therefore, it is recommended that you compare rates by visiting their websites.

#### **Credit Cards**

Major credit cards (VISA, MasterCard) are accepted at banks, hotels, shops, and restaurants in Japan. Shinkansen bullet train tickets and airplane tickets can also be purchased with credit cards.

#### **Electricity**

In Japan the power plug sockets are of type A. The standard voltage is  $100\ V$ .
