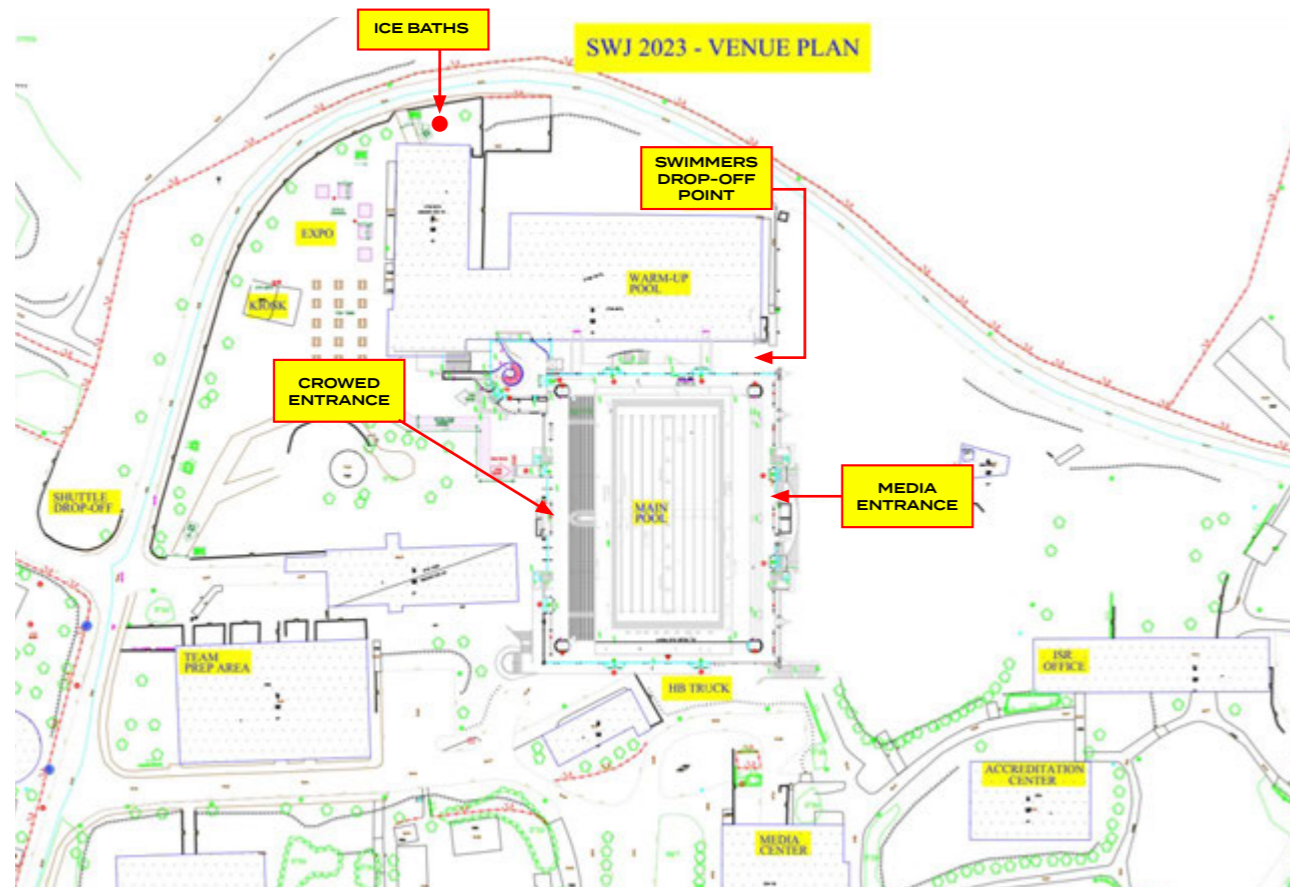

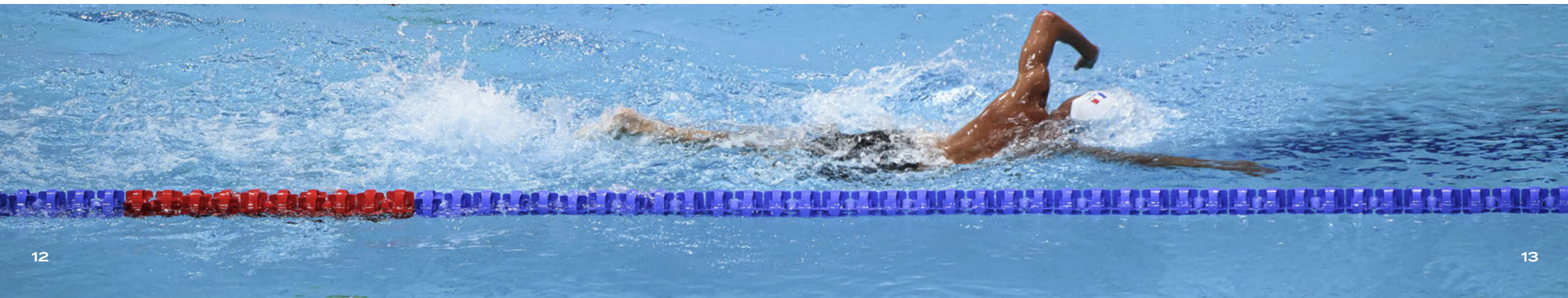
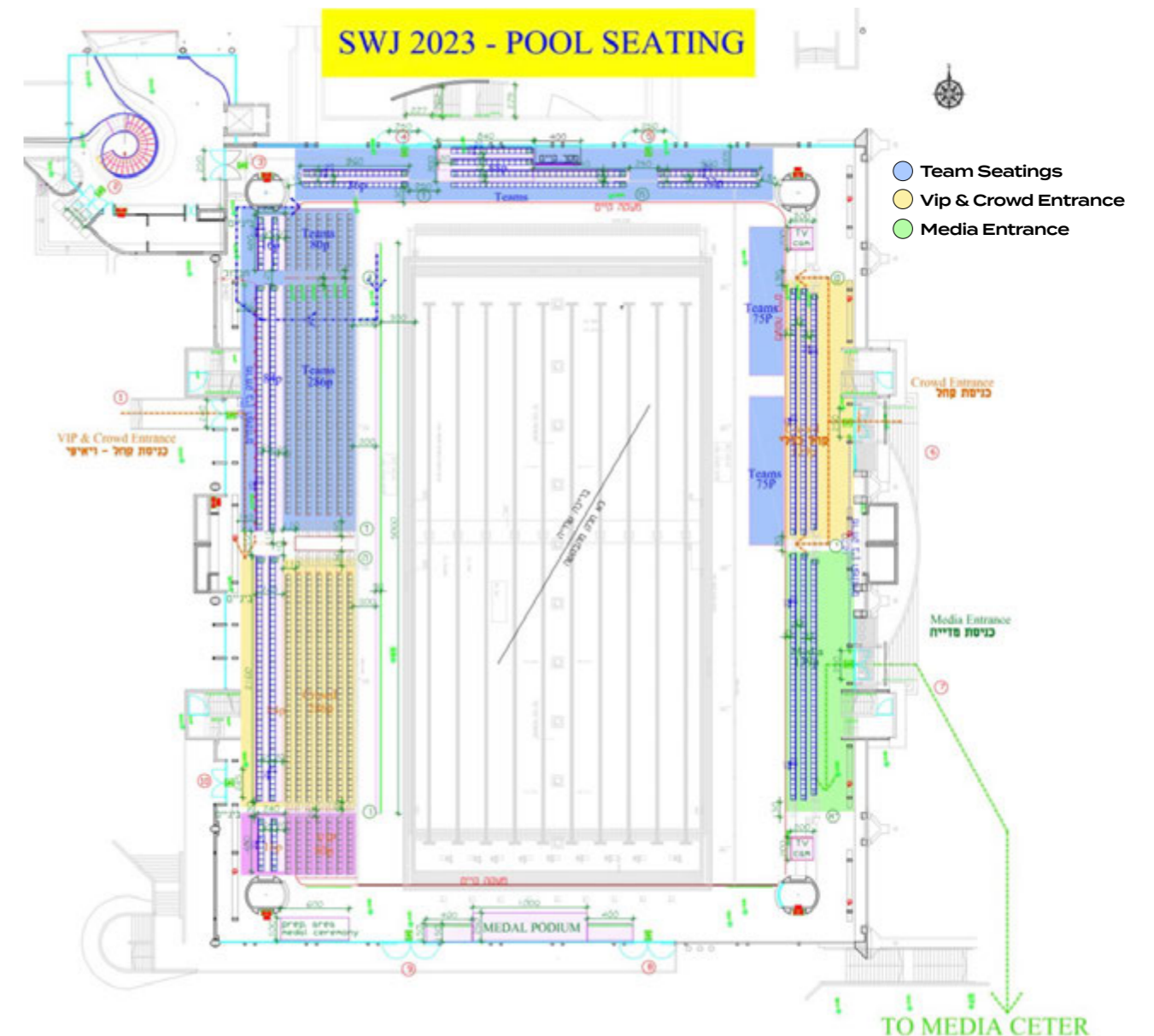

# Warm Up Guidelines

All lanes in the Competition Pool are CIRCLE SWIMMING ONLY, until 45 min. prior to the advertised time of end of warm up, when the competition pool converts to the following diagram:

### COMPETITION POOL:

- There is **NO DIVING AT ALL** until 45 min. Prior to the end of warm up, and then diving only in those lanes marked to do so.
- There is no **DIVING IN CIRCLE SWIMMING LANES**, entry to these lanes is to be feet first. Circle swimming is anti – clockwise.
- No paddles, fins or rubber bands are allowed in the competition Pool.
- Any time between sessions, the Competition Pool must be set up as above.

### WARM UP POOL:

- All lanes will be anti – clockwise circle swimming, with feet first entry at all times.
- Lanes 0 and 9 can be used for dive in sprints or relay exchange practice. The starting blocks must reflect the blocks used in the competition pool.
- Backstroke ledges should also be available in the Warm Up pool.

## Athlete Uniforms

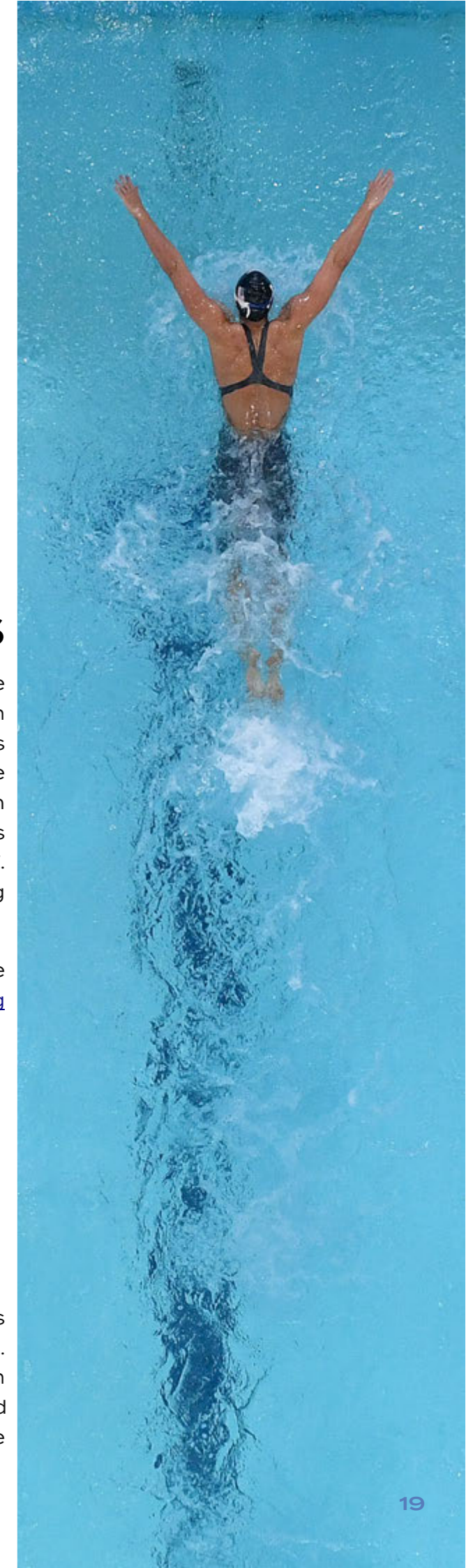
Each athlete is expected to compete in the official National Federation team uniform throughout the Championships. All uniforms and personal equipment must be in compliance with the World Aquatics Competition Regulations as outlined in the I. Rules Applicable to all Aquatic Disciplines, 7. Swimwear and Wearables, and 8. Advertising Identification.

## Procedures after the Competition

### Leaving the pool

Athletes should only leave the pool by the sides and not by climbing over the touchpads. Athletes must collect their accreditation from the accreditation table as they leave the Field of Play (FOP) before proceeding through the mixed zone.

## Mixed Zone

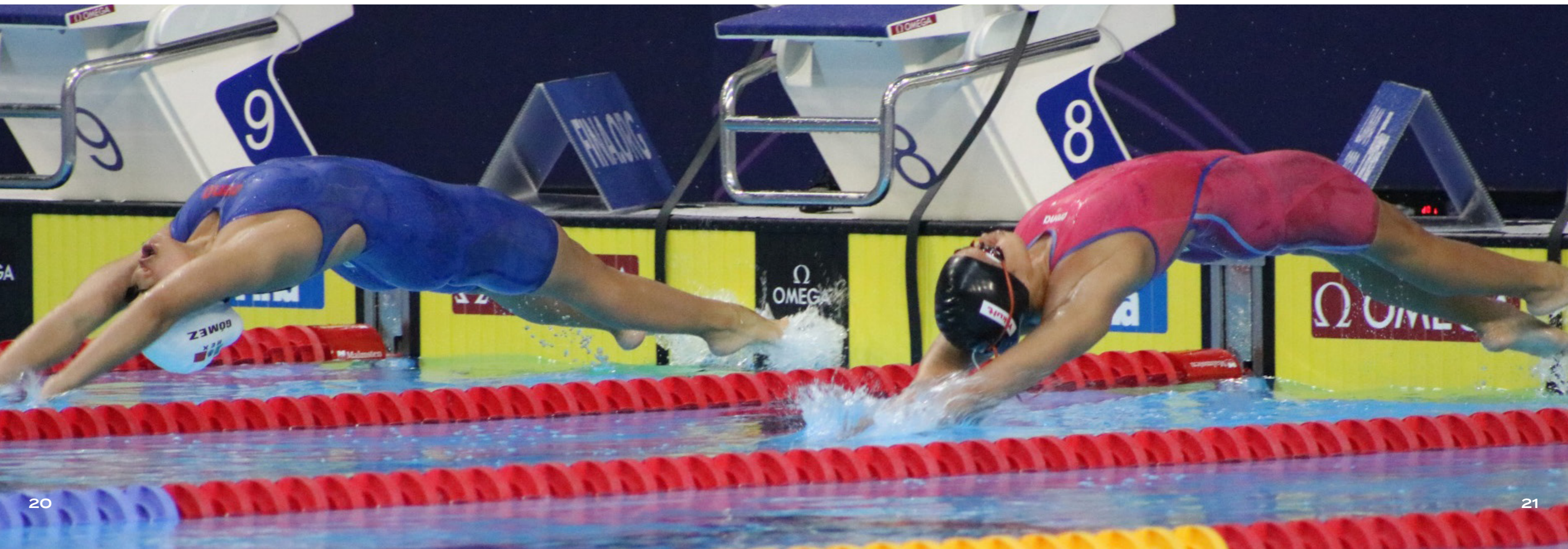
Athletes will go through the mixed zone. Every effort will be made to ensure that interviews are limited to a reasonable length of time so all athletes are able to make their statements before leaving the mixed zone.

## Medal Ceremonies

Medal ceremonies will be held at the venue during the finals sessions. Athlete chaperones will be on hand to advise and guide all athletes before, during and after the medal ceremony. Medal ceremonies will include playing the national anthem of each gold medal winner.

All athletes will attend medal ceremonies in the NF's sports uniform or in the uniforms approved for competitions. Athletes will not be allowed to stand on the podium if they are carrying flags, posters, unauthorized brands, or commercial slogans of any kind.

We remind you that as per the World Aquatics Code of Conduct, any political, religious, or discriminatory statement or behavior is strictly prohibited on the Field of Play (FOP), including during medal ceremonies.



# 4. SERVICES

## Sport Information Desk (SID)

The Sport Information Desk will operate at the entrance of the competition venue on competition days, as well as during scheduled training sessions. The Sport Information Desk will provide information on the competitions and will be in operation from the first day of training. The Sport Information Desk will operate similarly to a reception desk and is the primary point of distributing all Championships information including the following:

- Sport specific information for the competition held at the venue
- Official communication with teams
- Liaison among teams, competition management and the AQUA Technical Committee
- All documentation necessary for the Team Leaders Meeting
- Other miscellaneous enquiries

The SID is operated by sport-specific volunteers and supervised by Competition Management.

# 5. TRANSPORTATION

The athlete transportation bus system will provide the following services to athletes and accredited officials, including their sports equipment and luggage:

- Arrival and departure services between Ben Gurion International Airport and the official hotels.
- Transportation services between the official accommodation and the competition and training facilities.
- Transportation will be available for any athlete held for the anti-doping process after the competition.

## Competition days

- For the heats the bus will leave at approximately 07:00 hours from each hotel to Wingate Institute and will return to the hotel at until 1.5 hr after the session.
- For the semi-finals and finals, the bus will leave at approximately 15:30 hours from each hotel to Wingate Institute and will return to the hotel until 1.5 hr after the session.

## Training Days

- The first bus will leave at approximately 07:30 hours from each hotel to Wingate Institute and it will be adjusted according to the training schedule.
- The last bus will leave the Wingate Institute to the hotels at 19:30 hours.

## OTHERS

### Language

Hebrew is the official language throughout Israel but most of the people in Israel understand and speak English.

### Climate

In September Weather in Netanya daily maximum temperatures are around 27 °C, rarely dropping below 18 °C or exceeding 30 °C.

Daily minimum temperatures are around 18 °C, rarely fall below 14 °C or exceed 20 °C.

Israel uses 220 volt electricity, so will need a converter for 110 volt devices.

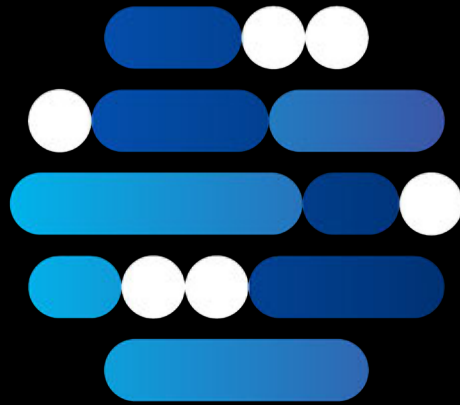
Most plugs in Israel are the three-pronged circular type, but a two-pronged circular type are also found. An adapter may be necessary depending on which type your devices use.
