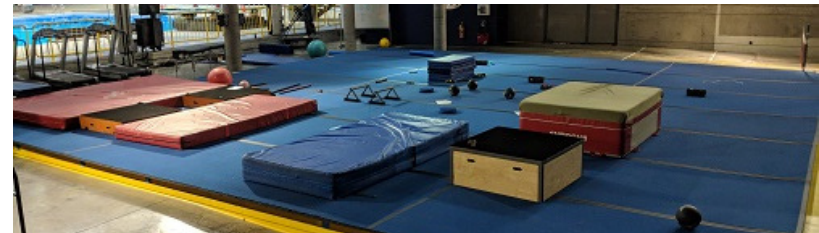

All nominations and sport entries shall be made electronically via the AQUA General Management System (GMS) **by the deadline of January 10th, 23.59 GMT.** [CLICK HERE](#)

Access to the registration system should be via the logins previously supplied to your federation. If you require any assistance with the registration process, please contact gms@worlaquatics.com.

04 TRAVEL INFORMATION

AIRPORT

All arrivals and departures must be done to and from **Montreal-Trudeau International Airport (YUL)**. The LOC will have an information booth in the international terminal. Please see Diving Canada's staff at the desk when arriving in Montréal.

Please be reminded that transportation from the airport will only be coordinated if the flight information is entered correctly and on time in the GMS by January 19th.

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VISA and eTA PROCESS

Citizens of certain countries and territories need a visa or an eTA to visit or transit Canada.

Note. If you hold a passport other than Canadian or you are stateless, you need a visa to visit or transit in Canada.

Canada has introduced a requirement for countries that previously did not require a visa to enter Canada. An Electronic Travel Authorization (eTA) is an entry requirement for visa-exempt foreign nationals travelling to Canada by air.

An eTA is electronically linked to a traveller's passport. It is valid for up to five years or until the passport expires, whichever comes first.

Upon request sent to worldcup@diving.ca, the LOC will provide visa assistance by issuing an invitation letter. Please note that in the current context, we expect that issuing visas will take much longer than in the past and we urge you to begin this process as early as possible to avoid possible travel problems due to delays.

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05 PARTICIPATION

- STOPS 1 AND 2 – Open to all World Aquatics Member Federations
- Up to 2 entries per National Federation for the Individual Events.
- Up to 1 team per National Federation for the Synchronised and Team Events.
- Divers competing in the Team Event must be already registered for either the Individual or Synchronised Events.
- To participate, individual divers must meet the minimum point standards set by World Aquatics at a previous identified event. For the Synchronised Events, the standards need to be achieved by the National Federation and not necessarily by name of divers. The identified events are as follows:
 - The World Aquatics Diving World Cups 2023
 - Xi'an
 - Montreal
 - Berlin
 - The World Aquatics Championships – Fukuoka 2023*
 - The approved Continental Championships part of the Paris 2024 Olympic Qualification System
 - European Championships
 - Asian Games
 - Pan Am Games
 - Oceania Diving Olympic Qualification Event
 - African Games
 - The World Aquatics Diving Recognised Events 2023
 - Malaysia
 - Spain

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06 DIVING - RULES & FORMAT

The World Aquatics Diving World Cup - Montréal will be conducted under AQUA diving rules. Click [HERE](#) to see the World Aquatics rules and format. You can also refer to the World Aquatics Diving World Cup - Rules and Regulations [HERE](#).

The DWC Montréal 2024 will consist of the following 9 medal events:

- Individual diving - Men/Women - 3M Springboard/10M Platform
- Synchronised diving - Men/Women - 3M Springboard/10M Platform
- Team event

Please refer to the Rules and Regulations for further information on each of the events, especially on how the Team Event will work.

07 JUDGES

Each National Federation may nominate, at its own expense, one (1) or two (2) AQUA A-judges or G-judges, whether the federation is entering divers or not. National Federations entering 4 or more divers must provide at least 1 judge otherwise a USD 500 penalty will be charged to the National Federation. The judges must be included in the AQUA Diving Judges List 2024 (available here <https://www.fina.org/diving/officials>).

Please return the Judges Nomination Form as soon as possible, but no later than December 1st, 2023 to diving@worldaquatics.org and worldcup@diving.ca.

10 TRANSPORTATION

Free transportation is only provided for athletes, coaches and accompanying persons having booked one of the official event hotels with LOC.

13 DOPING CONTROL

Doping control procedures will be in place at the competition.

Divers are responsible for bringing government-issued photo ID (or a high-resolution copy) in case they are selected for doping control.

Divers are also responsible for any medication/supplement they are taking. Athletes under 18 must have a chaperone from their team to accompany them during their test.
