2024 World Aquatics Support Programme eligibility conditions

There are three key expectations for funding, with the primary criterion being the first one, which is also a disqualifying factor. Only National Federations that have participated in the last two major World Aquatics competitions will be eligible for the World Aquatics Support Programme in 2024.



Condition 1: National Federation participated in at least one of the two latest World Aquatics Championships or Swimming World Championships (25m): Melbourne 2022 and/or Fukuoka 2023



Condition 2: Successfully finalized previous OASP & AQUASP editions



Condition 3: Answered the Governance Survey 2024 by 17 October 2023



2024 World Aquatics Support Programme guidance

- Only fully eligible National Federations will be able to apply from 1 November 2023 until 31 January 2024
- The Application Form will be sent via Survey Monkey, to your official National Federation's email address
- \$ Eligible World Aquatics Members will be subject to receive an amount of USD 25'000 for Aquatics development
 - National Federations improving their Governance score from 2023 to 2024 can earn a bonus of USD 5'000, with a maximum of USD 30'000 funding
 - At least one project must be related to the improvement and implementation of good governance standards. Based on your 2024 Governance Survey results, please choose an area of improvement. It has to be a different theme from 2023
 - 🙇 At least 75% of the total allocated funds shall be invested into Athletes Programmes, where athletes are the main beneficiaries
 - Once the application of your National Federation is approved, a confirmation form is going to be sent. The President or the Secretary General has to sign the document and return it fully scanned to World Aquatics Office
 - Funds will be disbursed in two parts: 70% upon AQUASP 2024 application approval, and the remaining 30% after project completion and submission of the Final Report
 - We encourage all World Aquatics Members to cooperate with other Aquatics Sports National Bodies (if such exist in the country) while preparing the AQUASP 2024 application. I.e., if a Swimming Federation is World Aquatics Member, they must contact other National Bodies responsible for Diving and Water Polo

Appendix 1: list of 2024 Governance survey questions

Main question of the Governance Survey 2024 1. Are your National Federation's Statutes, general rules or constitution in open access to general public? Does your National Federation hold elections of the President and Executive Board positions at least every four years? 2. Has your National Federation organized a General Assembly in the last 24 months? 3. Is there a rule/article linked to the representation of genders in the Executive Board in your statutes? 4. 5. Do you have at least 30% of each gender represented in the Executive Board? Is the information about the Executive Board Members (composition of the Board) in open access to general public? 6. Does the Executive Board of your National Federation meet at least twice per year? 7. Is there any limitation for the number of terms of the elected President and Members of the Executive Board in your statutes? 8. Is there any limitation for the age of the elected President and Members of the Executive Board in your statutes? 9. 10. Has your National Federation paid the 2023 World Aquatics membership fees on January 31st? 11. Does your National Federation have an Athletes' Committee? If you have an Athletes' Committee, is it represented in your Executive Board? 12. If you have an Athletes' Committee, which is represented in you Executive Board, does it have voting rights? 13. Are your National Federation's financial statements, budget and technical report, presented and approved annually, or at least every two years, by the 14. General Assembly?
