

The competition will be organized according to AQUA Artistic Swimming Rules and Regulations

ENTRIES & Participant Eligibility	In World Aquatics Junior Championships each country shall be entitled to enter one Women Solo Technical, one Women Solo Free, one Men Solo Technical, one Men Solo Free, one Women Duet Technical, one Women Duet Free, one Mixed Duet Technical, one Mixed Duet Free, one Open Technical Team, one Open Free Team and one Open Acrobatic Routine  For World Championships and World Junior Championships, team routines shall consist of eight (8) max competitors. A maximum of two (2) male competitors can be entered.	
COMPETITION FORMAT	The tentative Schedule will be updated soon. (Time limits as listed in AS 14)	
ELIGIBILITY AGE	According from the Rules (ASAG 2). All Age Group competitors remain qualified from 1 January to the following 31 December at the age they are at the close of day (23:59) on 31 December of the year of the competition. Female Age (15-19 years of age) Male Age (15 - 20 years of age)	
SCORING	Scoring will be accordi	ng to the AQUA Rules.
DOPING CONTROL	According to the AQUA DC Rules and the WADA international Standards.

# **06. TECHNICAL OFFICIALS**

Eligibility	Each participating Federation may nominate a maximum of one (1) judge qualified in category G or A from the AQUA list.  National Federations will be responsible for all their judges' expenses.  Judges cannot be assured of a spot on every event, but Federations may be assured that each judge will be seated enough times to receive a full evaluation by an AQUA evaluator.  Names of judges should be sent to World Aquatics angela.dubuis@worldaquatics.com for nomination and once approved, the National Federation is responsible to finalize the registration in GMS.
TECHNICAL CONTROLLERS (DTC)	To be nominated by World Aquatics.
NEUTRAL JUDGES	Federations may apply to send 1 neutral judge per ASWC event at their own expense.
Practice Judges	Each National Federation is allowed to send one (1) practice judge per stop and the Host Federation is permitted to have a maximum of two (2) Practice Judges. To be eligible to be a Practice Judge at any of the aforementioned competitions, the World Aquatics "G" Judge must have attended a Certification School and passed the exam with a required pass mark and successfully completed the Annual Online Assessment. World Aquatics "A" Judges are not permitted to be a Practice Judge at the competitions.









#### 07. MUSIC

All music files (routine music+ gala music + National Anthem) must be submitted and uploaded electronically before July 29th (instructions & link to portal will follow)

File must be labeled with the following information, all separated by underscores, with no blank spaces.

Federations must also have in their possession a digital copy of their music on USB sticks for use as backup if necessary.

#### 08. GALA

On Sunday Sept 1st, we will present an exhibition gala. All delegations must be prepared to participate in this final gala. Solo, duo, trio, accessories, make up. Everything is allowed to make this exhibition gala a spectacular show to finish our wonderful week together. Please note that participation in the gala, the sending of the sport presentation form and music are compulsory with the same deadlines as the events. The desired duration is about 1 minute for each performance, but this can be adapted slightly depending on the staging

#### 09. VISA INFORMATION

Upon request through the AQUA GMS and the IPF, Peruvian Swimming Federation will provide Visa assistance by issuing an invitation letter.

Please Note that in the current context, we expect that issuing visas will take much longer than in the past and we urge you to begin this process as early as possible, but at least 90 days before the date of the competition, to avoid possible travel problems due to delays.

We therefore invite you to complete all necessary visa information in the AQUA GMS by May 30th.
