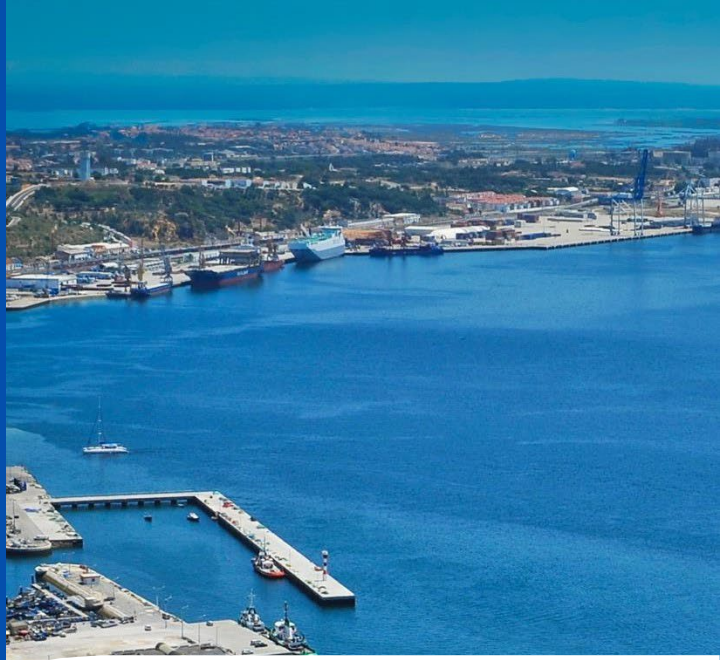

On behalf of the entire World Aquatics family, I welcome you to the World Aquatics Open Water Swimming World Cup 2025 series.

This year, the world's top open water swimmers will compete in a series of stunning destinations: Somabay, Egypt (21-22 February); Ibiza, Spain (25-26 April); Setubal, Portugal (14-15 June); and Golfo Aranci, Italy (10-11 October). The venue and date for the World Cup Finals will be announced later.

The crystal-clear waters of Somabay, Egypt, have become a favourite destination on the Open Water Swimming World Cup circuit. Following successful editions in 2023 and 2024 as part of the Egypt Aquatics Festival, this beautiful Red Sea venue will launch the 2025 season again.

The second stop takes us to Ibiza, where athletes will compete in the pristine waters of the Mediterranean Sea. Although Spain has hosted an impressive 49 World Aquatics events, this marks Ibiza's debut as a host for the world's finest aquatic athletes.

From Ibiza, the tour continues to Setubal, Portugal, a well-established locale for open-water swimming. Known for hosting key events such as the Olympic Marathon Swim Qualifiers in 2012 and 2016 and the Open Water Swimming World Cup for the past three years, Setubal's open ocean waters provide a familiar and challenging stage for the athletes.

Golfo Aranci, Italy, located on the beautiful Sardinian coast, returns as a host for the third consecutive edition of the Open Water Swimming World Cup. This Mediterranean venue is renowned for its vibrant local culture and breathtaking natural scenery.

We'll conclude the year with the World Cup finals. Details on this stop will be confirmed and communicated later.

With the dedicated support of the Local Organising Committees, local authorities, officials, and volunteers, I know you are in very safe hands in these great cities.

I extend my heartfelt gratitude to the host cities and sponsors for their continued trust and unwavering support in making 2025 a very special year for open water swimming. To all the athletes, I wish you the very best throughout this much-anticipated racing series.

If the Weather conditions do not favor outdoor training, a 25m indoor pool will be available

The World Aquatics Open Water Swimming World Cup, Setubal 2025 competition will include a 10k and a 3k Knockout swim race for men and women.

Awarding ceremonies will take place at the competition venue. Immediately after the race. All Announcements, instructions, and commands during the event will be in English.

9. PARTICIPANTS

Entries will be accepted only from National World Aquatics Member Federations which must also register a coach for each respective swimmer. A coach can be responsible for up to two (2) swimmers only. The coach is responsible for representing his/her swimmers at the Technical Meeting, and feeding the swimmer during the event. The World Aquatics Technical Delegate together with the Chief Referee will accept entries and register only swimmers accompanied by the respective coach who is in charge of swimmer recognition during the race. A swimmer without a coach present will not be allowed to start the race. Each National Federation that has entered one or more swimmers in an Event must also have at least one representative (e.g. team leader, coach) present.

10. ENTRY PROCESS & PROTOCOL

Registration:

All National Federation registrations and sport entries must be done through the World Aquatics General Management System (GMS) via <https://data.fina.org>. Each National Federation must complete their registrations before the designated deadlines.

Swimwear Protocol:

Swimwear worn shall be according to World Aquatics Competition Regulations I.7

11. TECHNICAL & TEAM LEADERS MEETING

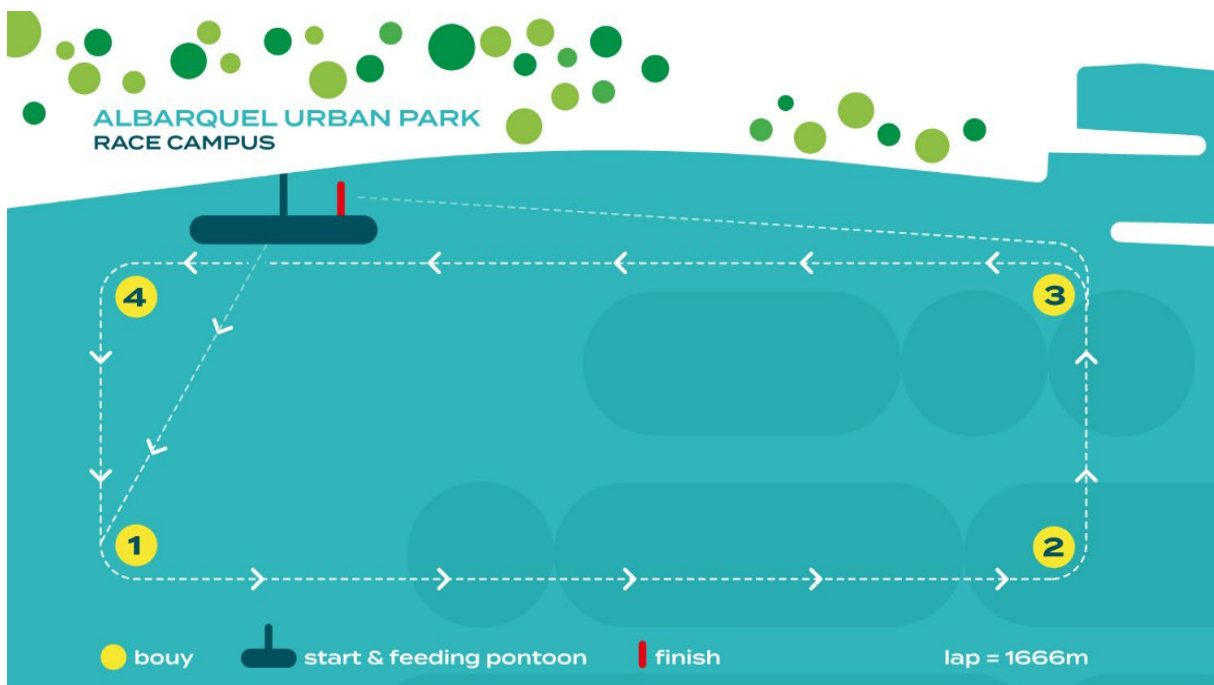
The Technical Meeting will take place on Friday the **13th of June at 18h30**. At least one representative from each National Federation must attend this meeting.

The Meeting will take place at the official Hotel - [Novotel](#).

12. VENUE & COURSE INFORMATION

The **10k** Competition will be organized on a **1.66km** course, swimmers must complete **6 laps**.

Sprint Winner for the 10km will be crowned at **Lap 1**



The **3k Knockout Sprint** event will be organized on a **1.5km /1km /0.5km** courses, same shape (More information will be shared closer to the competition).

13. RULES

Please note that all the events in the World Cup will be conducted according to latest World Aquatics Competition Regulations, in force at the time event.

14. ACCREDITATIONS & EVENT INFORMATION DESK

The Organizing Committee will provide all Swimmers and Team Staff with an official Accreditation card. Only accredited people will be allowed to access certain venue areas. All accredited people are requested to carry their Accreditation Cards with them at all times and to show them upon request.

Where to collect:

Accreditation can be collected at the Information Desk in the official hotel. Team managers will be required to present photographic identification for all team members.

The team Hotel will have an Information Desk where all the information will be provided, and where the accreditations will be delivered.

15. POINT SYSTEM & PRIZE MONEY

Point system and prize money distribution is explained within the [2025 Rules & Regulations](#).

Additionally, World Aquatics shall pay a minimum net total amount of five thousand United States dollars (US\$ 5.000) each to the men's and women's top 3 qualified athletes in the 3km Knockout Sprint, as follows:

Position	Prize Money
1 st	US\$ 2'500
2 nd	US\$ 1'500
3 rd	US\$ 1'000

16. MEDICAL

All Medical Support will be delivered by the local health authorities and in articulation with the World Aquatics Medical and Safety Officers, as well as World Aquatics Rules and Procedures.

17. VISA INFORMATION & TRANSPORTATION

All visitors to Setúbal, Portugal should have a valid visa for their entry and stay in the country.

The Portuguese Swimming Federation will facilitate an entry visa to Portugal to all participants and coordinate all the required procedures upon completion of registration in the World Aquatics GMS no later than **2 MAY 2025**.
