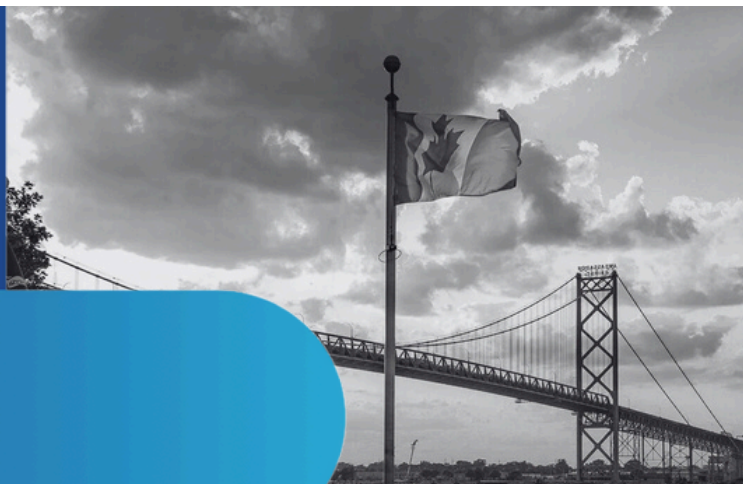

Dear friends,

It is a pleasure to welcome you to the 2025 edition of the World Aquatics Diving World Cup. This year's series will take us to three cities with deep ties to aquatics, each offering a unique stage for the world's best divers to compete at the highest level.

We begin in Guadalajara, Mexico from 3-6 April, marking a long-awaited return to a city with a rich diving history. With Olympic diving medals in every Summer Olympic Games since 1932, Mexico has long been at the heart of the sport, and the Centre Acuático Code Metropolitano - home to many of the country's top athletes - will undoubtedly provide a fitting backdrop for a memorable competition.

From there, we head to Windsor, Canada, from 10-13 April, a city with a well-earned reputation as a key diving destination. Canada's contribution to international diving is immense, and I have no doubt that Windsor's fans will help us proudly cheer on the athletes and celebrate the 2025 series.

Finally, the series culminates in the Super Final in Beijing, China from 2-4 May, where the legendary Water Cube will once again host the world's best divers. 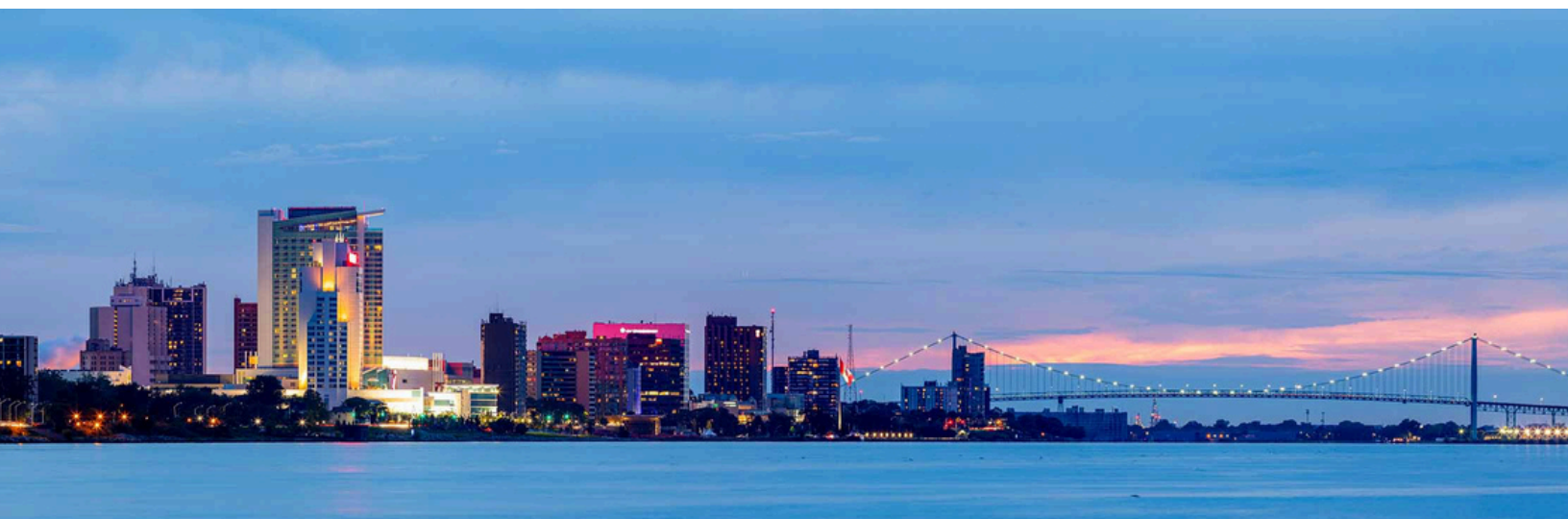

ELECTRONIC DIVE SHEETS SUBMISSION

World Aquatics in collaboration with Swiss Timing will launch for the first time the use of electronic Dive Sheets. Only one person per National Federation (NF) per competition will get credentials to submit dive sheets electronically on Dive Sheets Manager.

The designated person will receive an email from no-reply@st-software.com to log in on the website. They will then have the view of each event to enter their dive sheets. They will only see divers from their own NF entered in each event. Each event will be open until 24 hours before the Preliminaries or direct Finals as per the [World Aquatics Competition Regulations](#).

All phases (Preliminaries and Finals) shall be completed and submitted for each event with athletes entered to participate. After submitting each dive sheet, the owner will get a confirmation email with the dive list.

A detailed user guide will be provided shortly.

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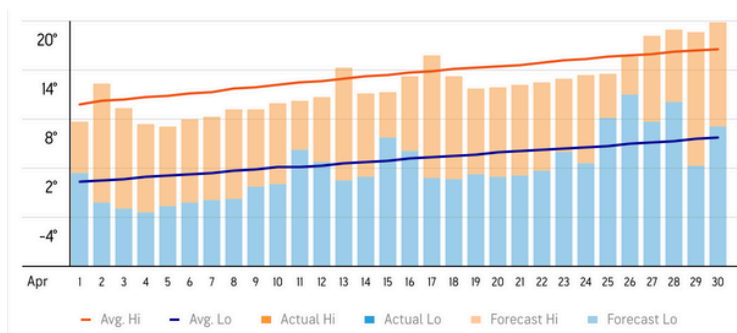

It is **SPRING** in Windsor in April. The weather **COULD BE** very variable. We strongly suggest that all participants come prepared for :

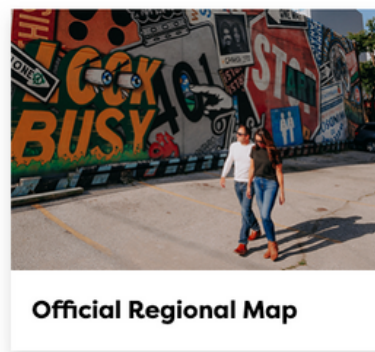

Your delegation will need their accreditation for entry/exit in the training facility to pass multiple security check points and to receive their meals. An accreditation station will be located at the pool beside the secretariat.

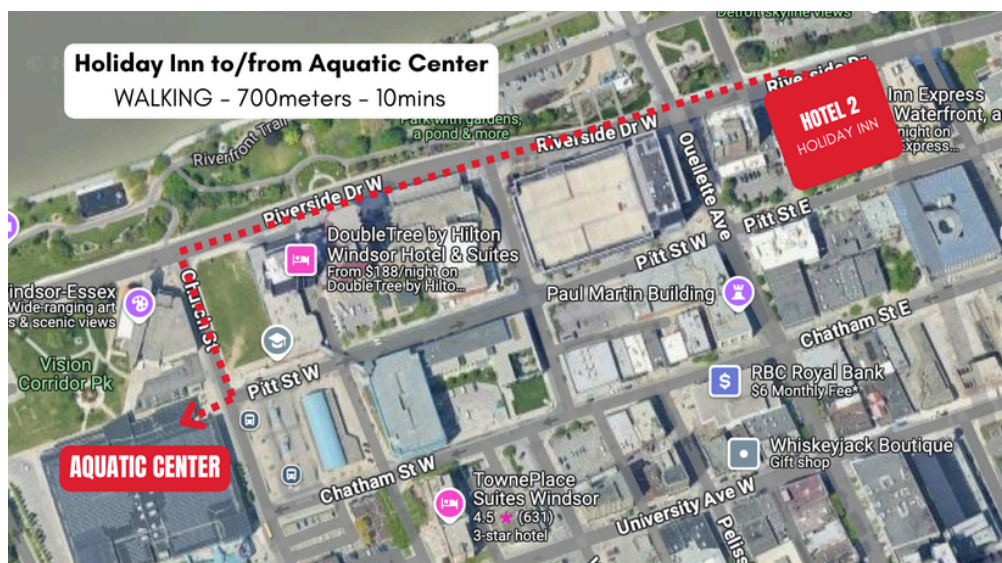
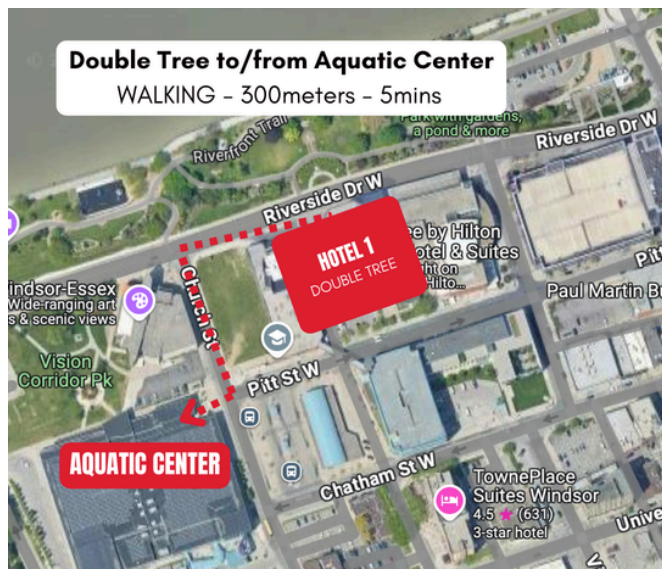

Only divers/coaches that are presently competing will be allowed in the field of play. A dedicated coaching area will be provided for team officials to coach their divers.

Divers and team officials not presently competing may remain on pool deck in the designated seating areas, in the dry-land training area or in the designated zones that are outside of the pool deck.

The best seating area for your athletes when not competing and/or training is located either in the stands or in the designated bleachers installed on the pool deck. As we want to ensure a smooth competition, we thank you in advance to be respectful in implementing this with your divers.

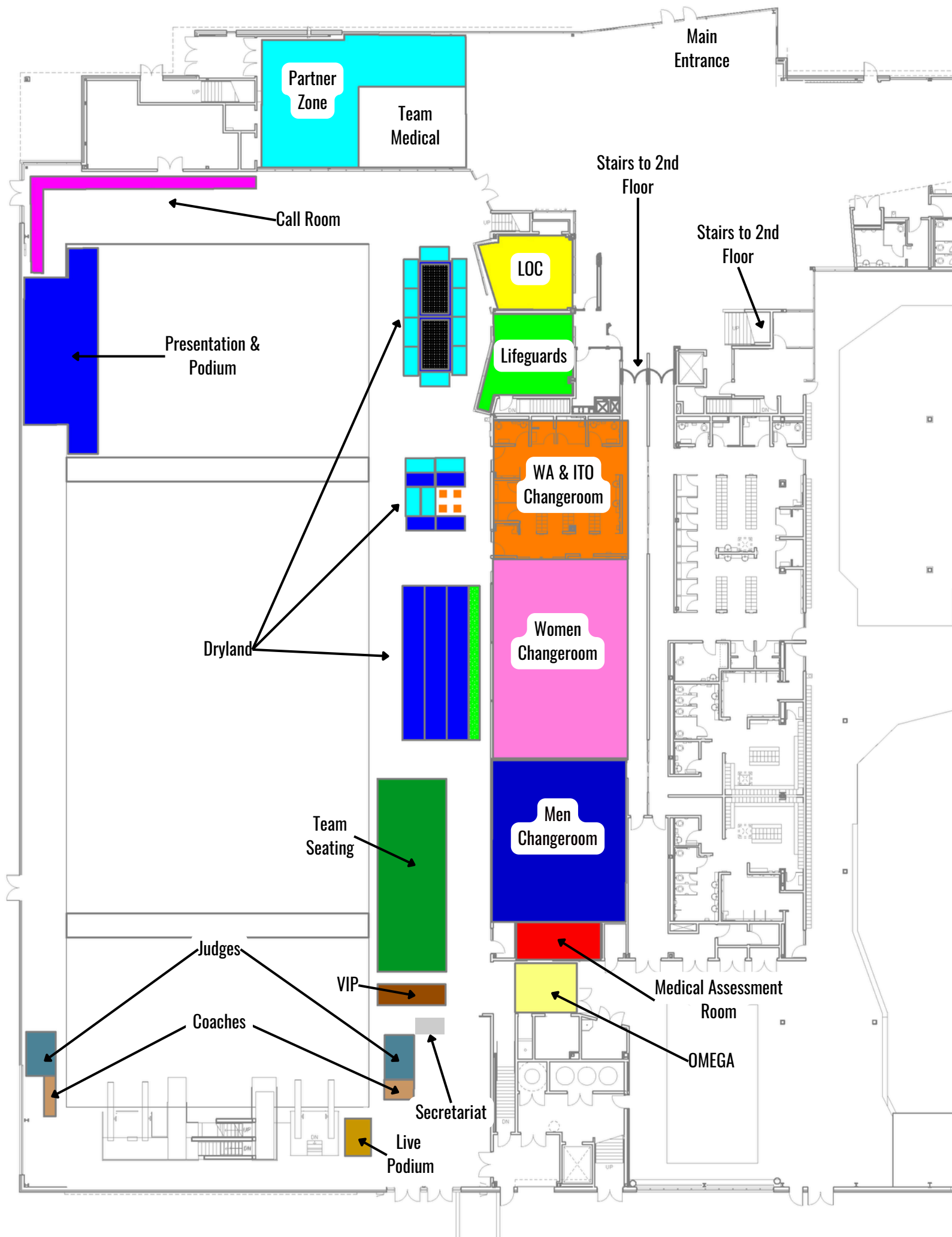


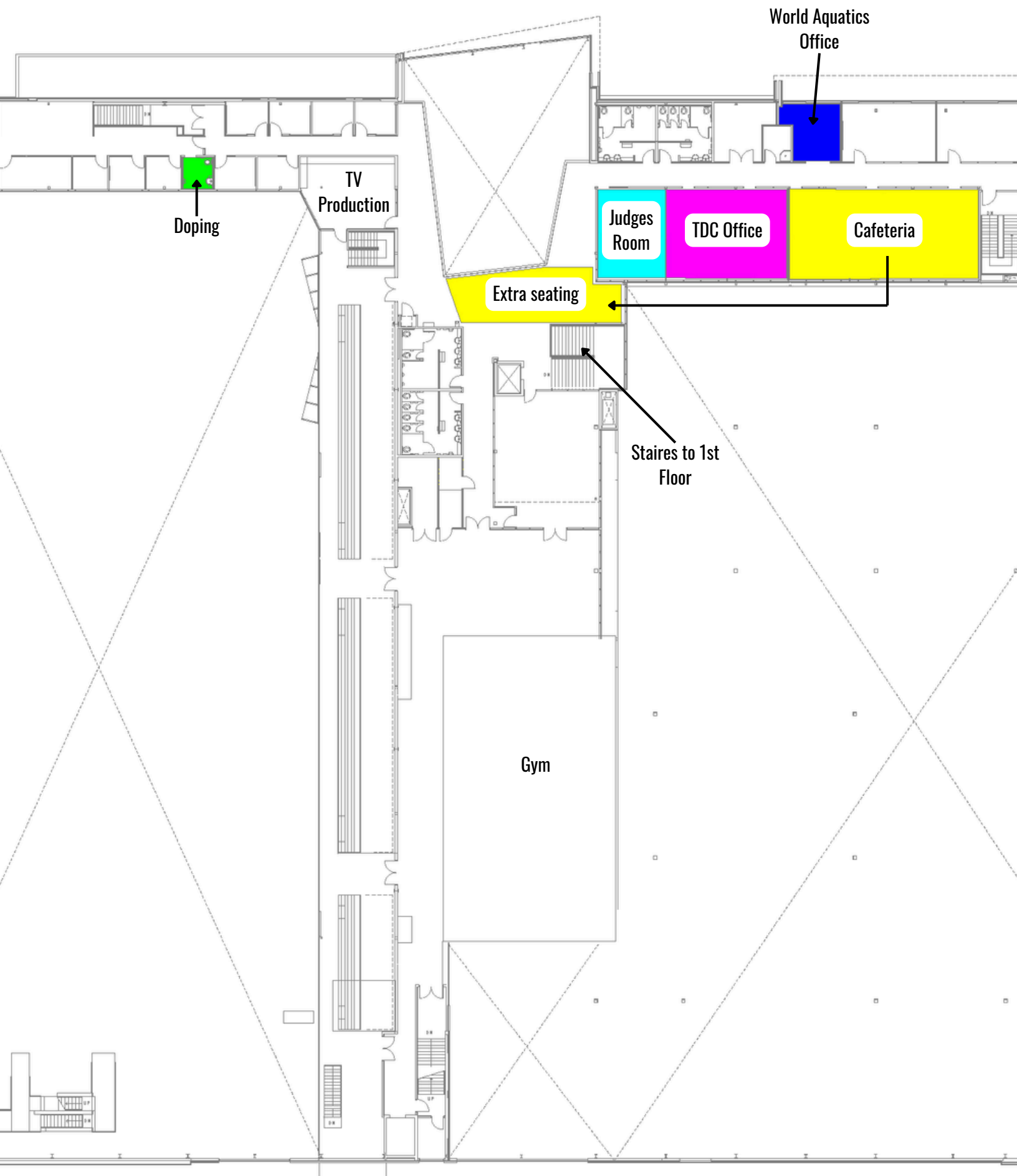

TREATMENT TABLES

Treatment tables will be available at the pool for teams to use. On training days, the treatment tables will be located on the pool deck, and on competition days, they will be located in a room adjoining to the pool deck with pool view.

Treatment rooms have been set up at both hotel for use on a first come first serve basis. Please see in each hotel lobby on the information board to know the room number.

PHYSICIANS

Access to a physician will be available daily from 8:00am to 6:00pm.

MASSAGE THERAPY

Free massage therapy service is available Thursday & Friday from 1:00 pm to 5:00 pm and Saturday from 11:00 am to 6:00 pm.

LIFEGUARDS & EMS SERVICES

Lifeguards will be onsite at the competition venue during training and competition to provide first aid. They are responsible to respond to all emergencies in the pool area. The lifeguards are the first responders and are station on each side of the pool deck. The team have received specific training to deal with diving emergency so they are prepared and ready.

They will initiate the EMS services procedures in place by the aquatic centre when needed. In case of an emergency, the EMS will decide which hospital the patient will be transferred to depending on the type of injury or illness.
