

#### Singapore 2025 efforts towards Sustainability

# A Community-Led Recycling Effort

Trash to Treasure: Singapore 2025 turns recycled aluminium into World Aquatics Championships medals.

This is a novel initiative by the Singapore 2025 Organising Committee to collect approximately 100,000 aluminium cans to produce 5,000 medals. Students from five PCF Sparkletots Preschool Centres, eight primary schools, and three secondary schools are leading the charge in this effort through the School Recycling League. This programme encourages students to actively participate in recycling activities, fostering environmental responsibility from an early age.

#### **Recycling Process**

The collected aluminum cans will undergo open-loop recycling, where they're processed, cleaned, and smelted into medals.

#### **Voices Behind the Movement**

Mr Mark Chay, Co-Chair of the Singapore 2025
Organising Committee, highlighted the
significance of integrating sustainability into
major sporting events: "Sustainability is a key
consideration for organisers of large-scale
events as we strive to reduce our
environmental impact. The 'Trash to Treasure'
initiative demonstrates how simple, greener
habits can be seamlessly incorporated into
daily life while driving meaningful change. The
enthusiasm of students and schools in this
programme is truly inspiring and underscores
the power of collective action."

#### Fun Facts about the Medals

The medal weigh approximately 150 grams, incorporating recycled materials instead of new raw aluminum. Approximately 20 recycled cans were used to create each medal.



#### PRE-TRAVEL

#### **Passport Validity**

All passports will need a minimum of 6 months' validity.

#### Visa

All participants of World Aquatics Masters Championships – Singapore 2025 are to check if an Entry Visa into Singapore is required.

Short term travelers holding a passport or travel document from a visa-required country/region must apply for a Visa.

Visa-required travelers can use the <u>Visa-Free Transit facility</u> for stay of less than 96 hours in Singapore, if eligible.

#### Visa applications may be submitted:

Through an authorised visa agent appointed by the Singapore Overseas Missions; or at the nearest <u>Singapore Overseas Mission</u>.

All foreign visitors arriving in Singapore <u>will be notified digitally of their Visit Pass (e-Pass)</u> <u>through email.</u> There will not be any endorsement on your passport. The e-Pass notification will indicate the period of stay granted and last day of stay allowed.


#### Rules for Photographers

- Photo positions shall be available at each venue of the Championships and are marked with a PHOTO signage.
- Photographers must be in position before the start of the competitions.
- Photographers should remain in position during competition and may only move during breaks in that competition.
- Photographers are not allowed to use any tripod, ladder or flash (during the competitions).
   The flash may be used only at the victory ceremonies.
- Training sessions are not open to photographers.
- Taking videos with any device is strictly prohibited.
- Devices generating their own Wi-Fi (Wi-Fi hotspots) networks are strictly prohibited. They
  will be deactivated in case of use.
- All remote-control cameras have to be approved by Media Operations 24 hours in advance.
- Special care must be taken with photographic equipment for the safety of the athletes.
- Mobile phones should be set to silent mode whenever in the Field-of-Play areas.
- Recording videos of the competition on your mobile phone is strictly prohibited.
- At any photo position, a strict 'NO BAG' policy applies. Bags will be safely removed, the constant breaching of this rule shall result in revoking the accreditation.
- Positions on the photo stands cannot be reserved (apart from the assigned agencies for operating the underwater cameras). Photo equipment left on the photo stands will be removed at the end of each session.
- Underwater cameras and usage of the catwalk are reserved for pool photographers and are subject to approval by the OC.
- Depending on and the event, the Venue Photo Manager can reserve photo positions (seats)
   based on a priority list. An escort for those positions will be present at all times.
- Photographers are not allowed to capture photos in the Mixed Zones.
- In all accredited areas, a strict NO SMOKING policy applies.
- Photographers should always wear appropriate clothing and wear their Photo Bibs.

### **Medical Services**

During the World Aquatics Championships, the Singapore 2025 Organising Committee ensures the provision of medical services to cater to the healthcare needs of participants and guests. The organising committee places significant importance on the well-being and safety of individuals during the events. The medical services provided will include:

### **Medical Care**

Available at all competition and training venues covered by trained medical professionals, including doctors, nurses, and paramedics, to offer immediate medical assistance. They are equipped to handle minor injuries, illnesses, and medical emergencies that may arise during the Championship.

### **First Aid Stations**

First aid stations are set up at various event locations to provide basic medical care. These stations are equipped with essential medical supplies and equipment to treat minor injuries, such as cuts, bruises, or sprains.

### **Ambulance Services**

Ambulances will be stationed at strategic points to ensure rapid response in case of any serious medical emergencies. They are equipped with essential medical equipment and can transport individuals to nearby hospitals.







# Language

The languages of Singapore are English, Mandarin Chinese, Malay and Tamil, with the lingua franca between Singaporeans being English, the de facto main language in daily, governmental, legal, trade and commercial affairs.

Among themselves, Singaporeans often speak Singlish, an English blend arising from centuries of melding between Singapore's multi-ethnic and multilingual society and its legacy of being a British colony.

## Climate and Time Zone



Enjoy summer all year-round with Singapore's tropical climate (25-33 °C). Dress in light, airy clothing and bring along an umbrella in case of occasional rainfall. Singapore Standard Time is situated in GMT +8 time zone, so be sure to calibrate your watches accordingly.

## Power Plug



The standard electrical current used in Singapore is 220-240 volts AC (50 cycles) and you may use power plugs with three square prongs here. It is recommended to check the compatibility of your devices with the voltage and plug types in Singapore before your trip. Some devices, such as laptops, smartphones, and camera chargers, are often compatible with a wide range of voltages and may only require a plug adapter.

Most hotels will exchange currency or offer bills of smaller denominations appropriate for tipping and other incidentals. However, there is no tipping culture in Singapore. Smaller retailers in Singapore may accept cash payments only.

## Safe Drinking Water



Tap water in Singapore surpasses World Health Organization standards. You may drink water straight from the source or easily purchase them from stores. It is important to stay hydrated, especially in Singapore's climate, so carrying a reusable water bottle and refilling it with tap water or purchasing bottled water is a good practice




