Award ceremonies will take place at the competition venue, immediately after the race. All Announcements, instructions, and commands during the event will be in English.

8. PARTICIPANTS

Entries will be accepted only from National World Aquatics Member Federations which must also register a coach for each respective swimmer. A coach can be responsible for up to two (2) swimmers only. The coach is responsible for representing his/her swimmers at the Technical Meeting, and feeding the swimmer during the event. The World Aquatics Technical Delegate together with the Chief Referee will accept entries and register only swimmers accompanied by the respective coach who is in charge of swimmer recognition during the race. A swimmer without a coach present will not be allowed to start the race. Each National Federation that has entered one or more swimmers in an Event must also have at least one representative (e.g. team leader, coach) present.











9. ENTRY PROCESS

Registration: All National Federation registrations and sport entries must be done through the World Aquatics General Management System (GMS) via https://data.worldaquatics.com/ Each National Federation must compete their registrations before the designated deadlines.

10. TECHNICAL & TEAM LEADERS MEETING

The Team Leaders Meeting (TLM) will take place on October 9 at 17:00 at the Hotel Marana.

11. VENUE & COURSE INFORMATION

The **10km** competition will be organised on a **1666m** course. Swimmers will have to complete **6 laps**.

Sprint Winners: Prize Money will be awarded for the top 3 ranked athletes at the first lap of the 10km event.

For the **Mixed 4x1500m Team Relay**, the same shape of the 10km event will be used, but the course will be only **1500m**.

The 3k Knockout Sprint event will be organized on a 1.5km /1km /0.5Km courses, same shape

The exact design of the competition courses will be shared with the teams closer to the competition.

12.RULES

Please note that all the events in the World Cup will be conducted according to latest World Aquatics Competition Regulations, in force at the time event.

13. ACCREDITATIONS & EVENT INFORMATION DESK

The Organising Committee will provide all Athletes and Team Officials with an official Accreditation card. Only accredited people will be allowed to access certain venue areas. All accredited people are requested to always carry their Accreditation Cards with them and to show them upon request.

Where to collect:

Accreditation can be collected at the Information Desk in the official hotels. Team Leaders will be required to present photographic identification for all team members. The team Hotel will have an Information Desk where all the information will be provided, and where the accreditations will be delivered.









14. POINT SYSTEM & PRIZE MONEY

Point system and prize money distribution is explained within the 2025 Rules & Regulations World Aquatics Open Water Swimming World Cup 2025, Rules and Regulations can be found here.

Additionally, World Aquatics shall pay a minimum net total amount of five thousand United States dollars (US\$ 5.000) each to the men's and women's top 3 qualified athletes in the 3km Knockout Sprint, as follows:

15. MEDICAL

All Medical Support will be delivered by the local health authorities and in articulation with the World Aquatics Medicaland Safety Officers, as well as World Aquatics Rules and Procedures.

16. VISA INFORMATION & TRANSPORTATION

The Italian Swimming Federation will facilitate the process of obtaining an entry visa to Italy by issuing a support letter to present at the Italian Embassy in your Country. All participants needing a Visa are requested to contact us (logistics@federnuoto.it) no later than the 25th of August 2025.

Transfers services will be provided free of charge only for the National Federations arriving at the Olbia Airport and harbour (15/20 minutes to both hotels). Local transportation between Hotels and training/competition venue will be provided as well.

CANCELLATION POLICY

Cancellations made before the 20th September 2025 will not incur any penalty.

19. ANTIDOPING

Urine and blood samples will be collected during the Open Water Swimming World Cup 2025, Golfo Aranci for the purpose of doping controls. The doping controls will be done in accordance with the World Aquatics Doping Control Rules and the World Anti-Doping International Standards, which can be consulted here. The operations will be supervised and coordinated by the International Testing Agency (ITA).

The list of prohibited substances can be consulted here. For reminder, all athletes are strictly responsible for any prohibited substance found in their sample and it is particularly important for them to check any medication they take against the prohibited list. Additionally, all athlete support personnel are responsible to be knowledgeable about anti-doping regulations and procedures.

1.1. Mandatory Anti-Doping education course prior to participation

Athlete

As per the World Aquatics Doping Control Rules, any athlete participating in World Aquatics Events must, prior to participation, have successfully completed the eLearning Anti-Doping Education course "International-Level Athletes Education Program" or an eLearning course developed and approved by their respective National Anti-Doping Organization that covers the same topics. Any athlete who has not met this requirement will not be eligible to compete and thus will not have their accreditation activated.

Team Official: Coach, Head Coach, Chef de Mission, Team Leader, or Support Staff

As per the World Aquatics Doping Control Rules, anyone registered as a team official—including coach, head coach, chef de mission, team leader, support staff—for World Aquatics Events must, prior to participation, have successfully completed the eLearning Anti-Doping Education course "Coaches of High Performance Education Program" or an eLearning course developed and approved by their respective National Anti-Doping Organization that covers the same topics. Anyone who has not met this requirement will not be eligible to participate and thus will not have their accreditation activated.

Team Official: Doctor, Medical Professional, Massage Therapist, or Physiotherapist

As per the World Aquatics Doping Control Rules, anyone registered as a team official—including doctor, medical professional, massage therapist, physiotherapist—for World Aquatics Events must, prior to participation, have successfully completed the eLearning Anti-Doping Education course "ADEL for Medical Professional's Education Program" or an eLearning course developed and approved by their respective National Anti-Doping Organization that covers the same topics. Anyone who has not met this requirement will not be eligible to participate and thus will not have their accreditation activated.

Please follow these instructions in order to complete the course:









Step 1:

Access the eLearning course webpage here.

Step 2:

Click on "Register here" and follow the steps to register an account.

Step 3:

Sign in to the new account just created.

Step 4:


Based on the category, select the course "International-Level Athletes Education Program", "Coaches of High-Performance Education Program" or "ADEL for Medical Professional's Education Program" and complete the course to obtain at least 80% at the final exam at the end of the course. You can do the course again if you do not achieve 80% the first time. The athletes' course is available in twenty-three languages, the coaches' course in seventeen languages, and the medical professionals' course is offered in three languages. Each course takes up to 2-3 hours to complete. The courses can also be accessed through the "ADEL by WADA" mobile application.

Step 5:

Once the course has been successfully completed, download the certificate of completion, and send it to your World Aquatics Member. The ADEL guidelines to download the certificate can be found here.

Step 6:

The World Aquatics Member must upload the certificate of completion of each athlete on their respective GMS profile here (in the Sport tab).















Note: In order to avoid any issues, Members should not wait until their teams are finalised to inform their athletes and team officials about this requirement. Rather, they should ask all athletes and team officials who could potentially participate in the event to complete the course immediately.

Athletes and team officials are encouraged to renew their certifications every four years to stay up to date with the latest anti-doping regulations and procedures.

1.2 World Records and World Junior Records

As per the World Aquatics Doping Control Rules, any Athlete equalling or breaking a World Record or World Junior Record in Swimming, shall be tested immediately after the race, or at the latest, 24 hours after the race. If not selected for doping control after the race, it is the sole responsibility of the athlete(s) to come to the doping control station to request being tested.

1.3 Continental or National Record

Should an Athlete equal or break a continental or a national record, it is the sole responsibility of the athlete(s) to check whether the rules of their Continental Organization or Members require a negative doping control in order to recognize the record. If this is required, the athlete must go to the doping control station to request a doping control test. This test will have to be paid by the athlete or their Member.
