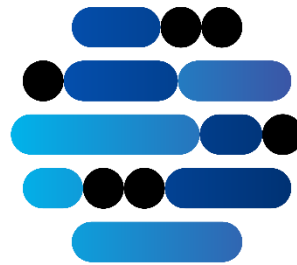
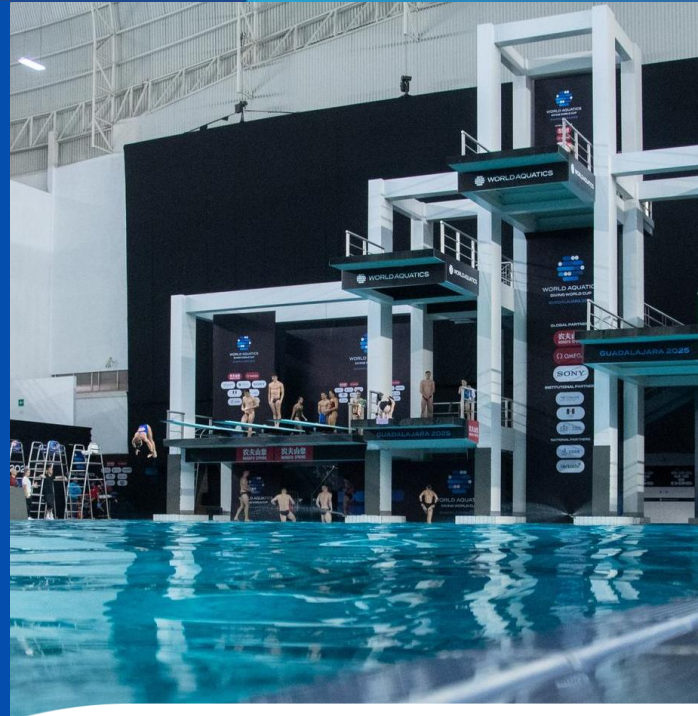

# PRESIDENT'S MESSAGE

## World Aquatics Diving World Cup 2026

Dear friends,

It is my great pleasure to welcome you to the 2026 edition of the World Aquatics Diving World Cup. This year's series will be hosted across three cities with proud aquatic traditions, each offering a distinctive setting for the world's best divers to showcase their talent on the global stage.



Once again, the world's diving elite return to Montreal, Canada, to open the 2026 Diving World Cup from 26 February to 1 March. A renowned host of major sporting events – including the 1976 Olympics and 2005 World Aquatics Championships – Montreal has a rich diving history, having hosted 14 World Aquatics Diving World Cup and Grand Prix events, as well as the 2022 World Junior Diving Championships. The historic Montreal Olympic pool - a hub for both community and elite sport for over 50 years - will once again be the competition venue.

From Montreal, the Diving World Cup moves to Guadalajara, Mexico, from 5–8 March 2026, marking the second consecutive year the city hosts the event. With Olympic diving medals in every Summer Games since 1932, Mexico has long been a cornerstone of the sport. The Centre Acuático Code Metropolitano – home to many of the country's top athletes – will provide a fitting backdrop for a memorable competition.

Following Guadalajara, the Diving World Cup concludes in Beijing, China, with the Super Final from 1–3 May 2026. The iconic Water Cube, officially the National Aquatics Centre, will host the world's top divers. Steeped in Olympic history, including the 2008 Games, Beijing has also staged 11 World Aquatics Diving World Cups. With its passionate fans and strong commitment to elite aquatics, the city provides a fitting finale for the 2026 tour.

With the build-up to the 2027 World Aquatics Championships and the LA28 Olympic Games in sight – not to mention Beijing hosting the World Aquatics Championships in 2029 – this year's Diving World Cup series serves as a vital stage in the athlete's journey towards one of the most action-packed and crucial periods in the sport's history.

I want to extend my sincere gratitude to our host cities, local organizers, volunteers, and everyone working behind the scenes to bring these events to life – your efforts are extremely valued and appreciated.

To all the divers, I wish you the very best. Enjoy the competition, have pride and embrace this important moment in your career!

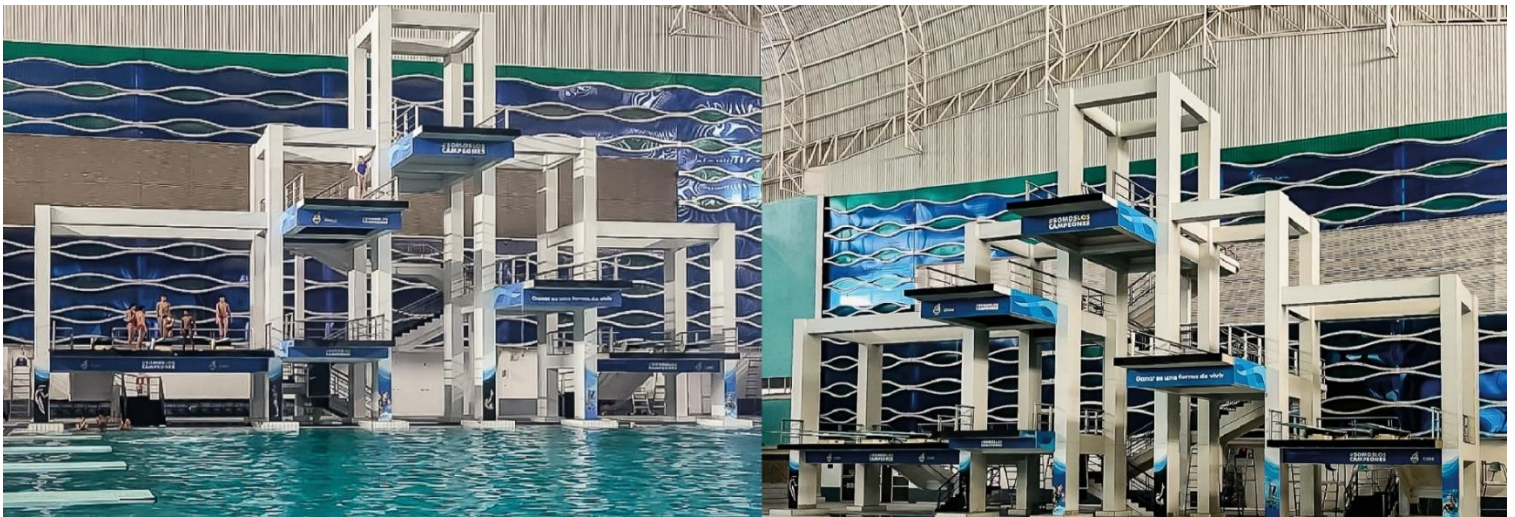

## TRAVEL INFORMATION

### AIRPORT

All arrivals and departures must be made to and from **Guadalajara International Airport (GDL)**. The LOC will have an information booth in the international terminal.

Please see Diving JALISCO's staff at the desk when arriving in Guadalajara.

Airport pick-up and drop off will be based on the travel details entered in the GMS. Please ensure these are entered correctly by **February 4th, 2026**.

### VISA and eTA PROCESS

Citizens of certain countries and territories need a visa to visit or transit Mexico. Click [HERE](#) to find out if you need a visa.

**Note.** Citizens with a valid visa from Canada, USA, Japan, Great Britain and countries from Schengen Area do not need a Mexican Visa, but need to fill a Mexican format: <https://www.inm.gob.mx/spublic/portal/inmex.html>

Upon request sent [presidencia@aquaticsmex.com](mailto:presidencia@aquaticsmex.com), the LOC will provide visa assistance by issuing an invitation letter. Please note that in the current context, we expect that issuing visas will take much longer than in the past and we urge you to begin this process as early as possible to avoid possible travel problems due to delays.

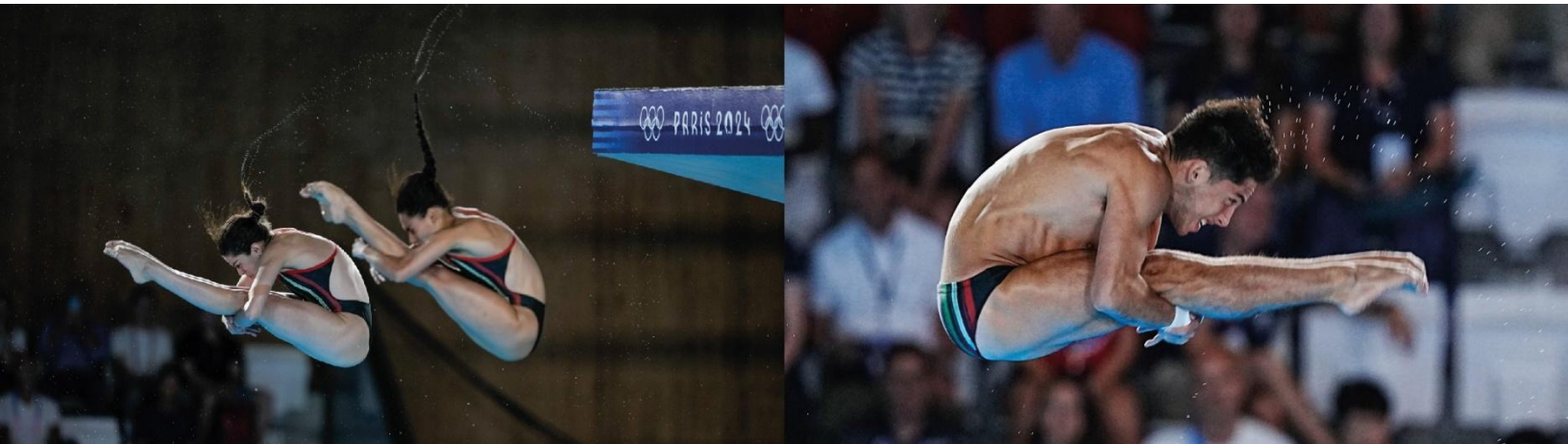

## PARTICIPATION

All World Aquatics Member Federations are eligible to participate at the Diving World Cup Stops 1 & 2 and the Super Final, except those under suspension.

Please refer to the World Aquatics Diving World Cup 2026 Rules and Regulations, available [HERE](#), for comprehensive details, especially on participation requirements and conditions of entry.



## RULES & FORMAT

The Diving World Cup Guadalajara 2026 will consist of the following 9 medal events:

- Individual diving - Men/Women - 3M Springboard/10M Platform
- Synchronised diving - Men/Women - 3M Springboard/10M Platform
- Mixed Team event

### ELECTRONIC DIVE SHEETS

World Aquatics in collaboration with Swiss Timing will continue using electronic Dive Sheets, as introduced in 2025.

Only one person per National Federation (NF) per competition will get credentials to submit dive sheets electronically on Dive Sheets Manager. World Aquatics will reach out to each of the participating NFs to obtain contact details.

The designated person will receive an email from [no-reply@st-software.com](mailto:no-reply@st-software.com) to log in on the website. They will then have the view of each event to enter their dive sheets.

They will only see divers from their own NF entered in each event. Each event will be open until 24 hours before the Preliminaries or direct Finals as per the World Aquatics Competition Regulations. All phases (Preliminaries and Finals) shall be completed and submitted for each event with athletes entered to participate.

After submitting each dive sheet, the owner will get a confirmation email with the dive list.

## JUDGES

Each National Federation may nominate, at its own expense, one (1) or two (2) World Aquatics certified judges from the official list (Gold, Silver, Bronze) whether the federation is entering divers or not.

National Federations entering 4 or more divers must provide at least 1 judge otherwise a USD 500 penalty will be charged to the National Federation.

National Federation must seek approval from World Aquatics by completing and returning the judges' nomination form at [diving@worldaquatics.com](mailto:diving@worldaquatics.com) by **January 9<sup>th</sup>, 2026**. The nomination form should be accompanied by a conflict-of-interest form.

## MEDICAL SERVICES

On-site medical services will be available to all participants from March 2<sup>nd</sup> to March 9<sup>th</sup>. In case of an emergency, the EMS will decide which hospital the patient will be transferred to depending on the type of injury or illness.

## DOPING CONTROL

Urine and blood samples will be collected during DWC Guadalajara 2026 for the purpose of doping controls. The doping controls will be done in accordance with the World Aquatics Doping Control Rules and the World Anti-Doping International Standards, which can be consulted [HERE](#). The operations will be supervised and coordinated by the International Testing Agency (ITA).

The list of prohibited substances can be consulted [HERE](#). For reminder, all athletes are strictly responsible for any prohibited substance found in their sample and it is particularly important for them to check any medication they take against the prohibited list. Additionally, all athlete support personnel are responsible to be knowledgeable about anti-doping regulations and procedures.

Each registered individual (athletes, supporting staff, NF rep, etc.) must complete a **mandatory Anti-Doping education course** prior to the event.

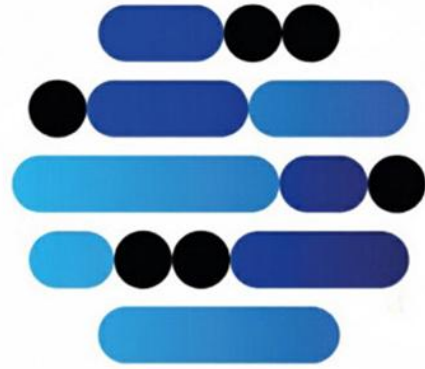

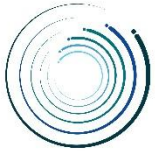
