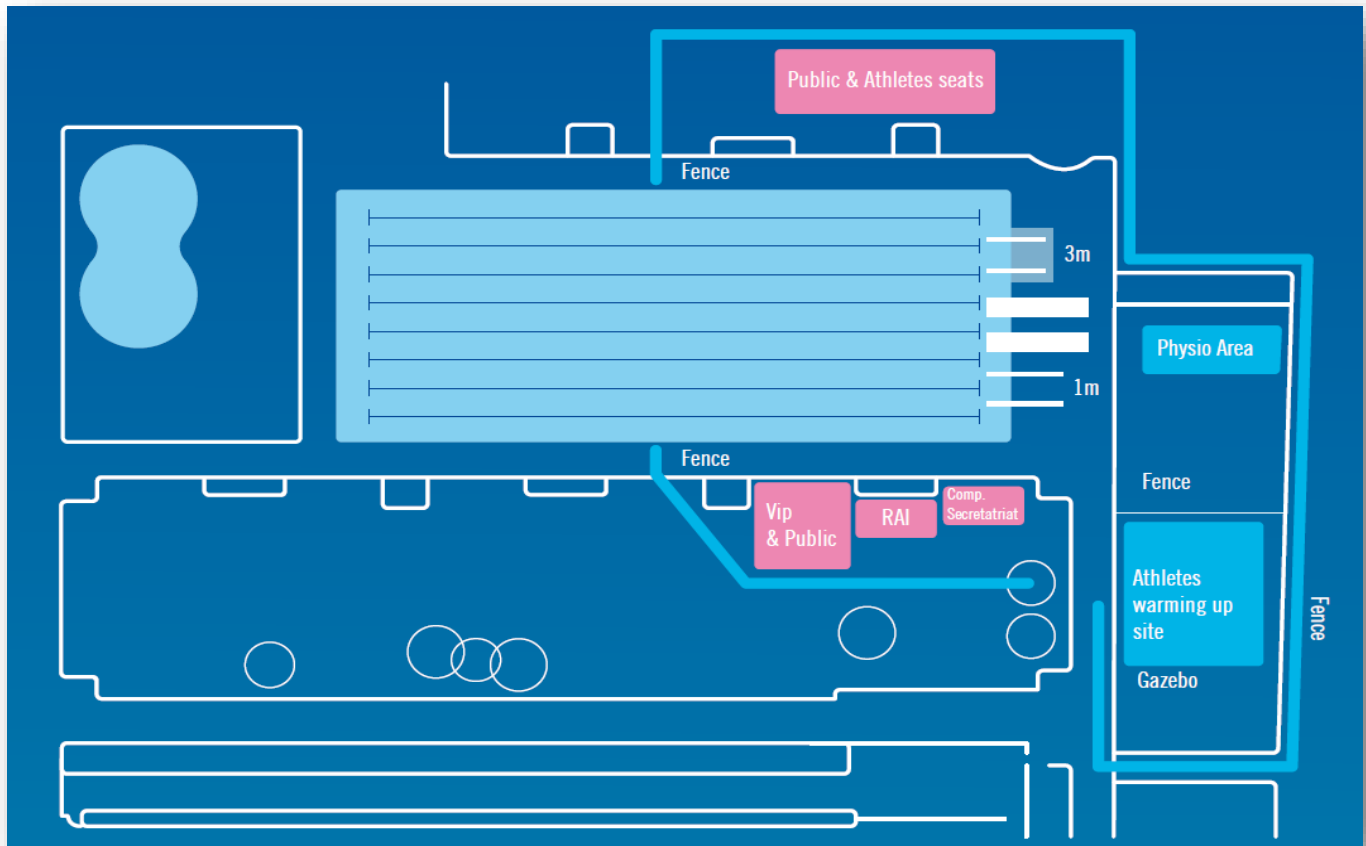

6. TRAVEL INFORMATION

The organizing committee will welcome all members of the participating National Federations at **Verona (VRN), Milan Bergamo (BGY) or Milan Malpensa (MXP) Airports** from **June 29 to July 06, 2026**. In case of more than one group arriving please contact us for a quotation. The organizing committee will provide transportation services between the airport, the official hotel, and the competition venue. Transport schedules will be provided upon arrival.

7. EXPENSES FOR THE PARTICIPANTS

The participation fee includes **participation** in the competition and **access** to the swimming pool and gym, **hotel stay, meals** at the hotel or competition venue (three meals per day), **gala dinner, transport** from the hotel to the competition venue and transfers from and to the airports mentioned above or train station. Participation fees are based on hotel accommodation (prices per day and person, subject to availability):

Each delegation can select the hotel category (4 stars - 3 stars superior - 3 stars) until places are available in the official hotels. Once availability has been exhausted, accommodation will be assigned in another hotel of equal category (if possible) or in a hotel of a lower category. In the latter case, the rate corresponding to the assigned hotel category in actual allocation will be applied.

Cancellation dates and policies

Bookings will only be confirmed upon receipt of the 50% deposit and will be allocated on a "first in" basis.

- Any cancellation prior to **25th May 2026** will not be penalized.
- Any cancellation between **26th May** and **15th June 2026** are subject to a 50% cancellation fee.
- Any cancellations from **16th June 2026 up** are subject to a 100% cancellation fee.

8. COMPETITION FORMAT

The Bolzano Diving Meeting Alto Adige - Südtirol will be held in accordance with the World Aquatics Rules, which can be found on the WA Website (<https://www.worldaquatics.com/rules/competition-regulations>). The prizes include medals and additional cash prizes and/or other presents for the athletes on the podium.

Conditions of Entry

- The Bolzano Diving Meeting Alto Adige - Südtirol shall be open to all World Aquatics affiliated Federations. Entries of divers will be accepted by World Aquatics Member Federations.
- In the Preliminary stage of individual events no limit of participants is requested
- Any Federation/nationality with more than two divers in an individual event may be permitted to qualify to the next stage only with the top two (2) performers in that event. In direct finals only one Team from the same nationality may proceed to the victory podium.
- The Synchro competitions will have a direct Final. The Host Federation may enter two (2) teams in the direct final of a synchro event but only the best team may proceed to the victory podium.
- There will be no opportunity for exhibition places.

Judges

- A Federation taking part with a team of four (4) divers or more should bring a World Aquatics-A or G qualified judge. The judge might, also serve as coach if this is not for a session where he/she is judging.
- World Aquatics will appoint a WA Delegate for this event. The WA Delegate shall conduct judging evaluations and shall report to the World Aquatics TDC Commission and the TDC Judges' Sub-Committee Coordinator.

Dives

Men's individual events	3m and 10m	6 dives without limit
Women's individual events	3m and 10m	5 dives without limit
Men's synchro events	3m and 10m	2 dives with limit + 4 dives without limit
Women's synchro events	3m and 10m	2 dives with limit + 3 dives without limit
Mix synchro events	3m and 10m	2 dives with limit + 3 dives without limit
Team Event	3m and 10m	6 dives without limit

Replacement of an injured diver

If a diver is unable to compete at the beginning of any session, the diver ranked next shall advance to the next session. In case of a tie in the last place of a session both divers will qualify. The same is valid for any tie on the podium.

Timetable and events are subject to changes based on television requirements and number of entries. The official opening ceremony will be held at the pool on **03rd July** before the start of the afternoon session. Training, competition and transportation schedules will be provided upon arrival.

10. MEDICAL CARE, LIFEGUARDS

Dedicated medical service at the competition venue is provided for the official training days and the three competition days (from Thursday to Sunday). Lifeguard is provided for the open training days, the official training day and the three competition days (from Tuesday to Sunday).

The Federations are responsible for all other necessary medical expenses. It is the responsibility of each Federation to provide adequate insurance coverage for its participants for any medical expenses due to illness or injury.

The organizing committee will provide info for the nearest Local Hospital and Ambulance service during the Event. The Public Emergency Medical Service is available 24 hours a day during the stay of the teams.
