

This year, the world's premier open water swimmers will compete across spectacular venues: Somabay, Egypt (27-28 March); Ibiza, Spain (24-25 April); Golfo Aranci (1-2 May); and Setubal, Portugal (20-21 June).

The crystal-clear waters of Somabay, Egypt, have become a top destination for elite open water racers. Following standout editions in 2023 and 2024 as part of the Egypt Aquatics Festival and last year's Open Water Swimming World Cup opener, this stunning Red Sea setting launches the 2026 season.

From Ibiza, the tour moves to Golfo Aranci, Italy, a distinguished destination for open water swimming – a Sardinian seaside village that most recently held the sport's 2025 World Cup Final.

Renowned for staging key events such as the Olympic Marathon Swim Qualifiers in 2012 and 2016, and the Open Water Swimming World Cup for the past three years, Setubal's open ocean waters offer a familiar and rigorous stage for this year's World Cup Final.

With dedicated support from organising committees, local authorities, officials, and volunteers, you are in safe hands in these great cities.

I offer my heartfelt gratitude to the host cities and sponsors for their steadfast trust and commitment to making 2026 a remarkable year for open water swimming. To all athletes, I wish you success throughout this eagerly awaited racing series.

Medal ceremonies will take place at the competition venue, immediately after the race. All Announcements, instructions, and commands during the event will be in English.

8. PARTICIPANTS

Entries will be accepted only from National World Aquatics Member Federations which must also register a team official for each respective competitor. A team official can be responsible for up to two (2) competitors only. The team official is responsible for representing their competitor(s) at the Team Leaders Meeting, and feeding the competitor during the event(s). **A competitor without a coach present will not be allowed to start the race** unless World Aquatics has been previously informed.

9. ENTRY PROCESS

All National Federation registrations and sport entries must be done through the World Aquatics General Management System (GMS) via <https://data.worldaquatics.com/> Each National Federation must complete their registrations before the designated deadlines.

10. TEAM LEADERS MEETING

The Team Leaders Meeting will take place on **April 30 at 16:00 at the Marana Hotel**. At least one representative from each National Federation must attend this meeting.

11. VENUE & COURSE INFORMATION

The Venue

The venue layout will be shared with all the teams closer to the competition via the World Aquatics Event Insider App.

Course Information

- The **10km** competition will be organised on a 1666m course. Swimmers will have to complete 6 laps.
Sprint Winners: Prize Money will be awarded for the top 3 ranked athletes at the first lap of the 10km event.
- For the **Mixed 4x1500m Team Relay**, the same shape of the 10km event will be used, but the course will be only 1500m.
- The **3k Knockout Sprint** event will be organised on a 1.5km /1km /0.5Km course, same shape as the 10km and Mixed 4x1500m Team Relay events but shortening the distances.

The exact design of the competition courses will be shared with the teams closer to the competition via World Aquatics Event Insider App.



12. RULES

Please note that all the events in the World Cup will be conducted according to latest World Aquatics Competition Regulations, in force at the time event.

13. ACCREDITATIONS & EVENT INFORMATION DESK

Accreditation

The Local Organising Committee will provide all competitors and Team Staff with an official Accreditation. Only accredited people will be allowed to access certain venue areas. All accredited people are requested to always carry their Accreditation with them and to show them upon request.

Accreditation can be collected at the Information Desk in the official hotel. Team Officials will be required to present photographic identification for all team members.

Information Desk

The official hotel will have an Information Desk where all the information related to the competition will be provided.

14. POINT SYSTEM & PRIZE MONEY

15. MEDICAL

All Medical Support will be delivered by the local health authorities and in articulation with the World Aquatics Medical and Safety Officers, as well as World Aquatics Rules and Procedures.

16. VISA INFORMATION & TRANSPORTATION

The Italian Swimming Federation will facilitate the process of obtaining an entry visa to Italy by issuing a support letter to present at the Italian Embassy in your Country. All participants needing a Visa are requested to contact us (logistics@federnuoto.it) no later than the **20 February**.

Transfers services will be provided free of charge only for the National Federations arriving at the Olbia Airport and harbour (15/20 minutes to both hotels). Local transportation between Hotels and training/competition venue will be provided as well.

The LOC will facilitate Airport Welcome and Transportation services upon filling in the Travel Information in the World Aquatics GMS by the deadline of **10 April**.

Transfers from other airports can be organised upon request. We will send you a quotation if needed.

18. CANCELLATION POLICY

Cancellations made before the 10th March 2026 will not incur any penalty.

Cancellations between 11th March and 10th April 2026 will incur a 50% charge of the total cost of the cancelled reservation.

Cancellations from 11th April 2026 onwards will be charged 100% of the total cost of the cancelled reservation.

19. ANTI-DOPING

Urine and blood samples will be collected during the competition for the purpose of doping controls. The doping controls will be done in accordance with the World Aquatics Doping Control Rules and the World Anti-Doping International Standards, which can be consulted [here](#). The operations will be supervised and coordinated by the International Testing Agency (ITA).

The list of prohibited substances can be consulted [here](#). For reminder, all athletes are strictly responsible for any prohibited substance found in their sample and it is particularly important for them to check any medication they take against the prohibited list. Additionally, all athlete support personnel are responsible to be knowledgeable about anti-doping regulations and procedures.

Mandatory Anti-Doping education course prior to participation:

Athlete

As per the World Aquatics Doping Control Rules, any athlete participating in World Aquatics Events must, prior to participation, have successfully completed the eLearning Anti-Doping Education course ["International-Level Athletes Education Program"](#) or a course developed by their respective NADO and recognised by the AQIU (Aquatics Integrity Unit).* Any athlete who has not met this requirement will not be eligible to compete and thus will not have their accreditation activated.

Team Official: Coach, Head Coach, Chef de Mission, Team Leader, or Support Staff

As per the World Aquatics Doping Control Rules, anyone registered as a team official—including coach, head coach, chef de mission, team leader, support staff—for World Aquatics Events must, prior to participation, have successfully completed the eLearning Anti-Doping Education course ["Coaches of High Performance Education Program"](#) or a course developed by their respective NADO and recognised by the AQIU (Aquatics Integrity Unit).* Anyone who has not met this requirement will not be eligible to participate and thus will not have their accreditation activated.

Team Official: Doctor, Medical Professional, Massage Therapist, or Physiotherapist

As per the World Aquatics Doping Control Rules, anyone registered as a team official—including doctor, medical professional, massage therapist, physiotherapist—for World Aquatics Events must, prior to participation, have successfully completed the eLearning Anti-Doping Education course “[ADEL for Medical Professional's Education Program](#)” or a course developed by their respective NADO and recognised by the AQIU (Aquatics Integrity Unit).* Anyone who has not met this requirement will not be eligible to participate and thus will not have their accreditation activated.

*** AQIU (Aquatics Integrity Unit) Recognised NADO Education Programs**

Please refer to the list of anti-doping education programs from National Anti-Doping Organisations (NADOs) whose certifications are recognised by the AQIU [here](#). These certifications will be accepted as fulfilling the mandatory anti-doping education requirements for all World Aquatics competitions.

Steps to Complete the ADEL Certification

Please follow these instructions in order to complete the ADEL course:

Step 1:

Access the eLearning course webpage [here](#).

Step 2:

Click on “Register here” and follow the steps to register an account.

Step 3:

Sign in to the new account just created.

Step 4:


Based on the category, select the course “**International-Level Athletes Education Program**”, “**Coaches of High-Performance Education Program**” or “**ADEL for Medical Professional's Education Program**” and complete the course to obtain at least 80% at the final exam at the end of the course. You can do the course again if you do not achieve 80% the first time. The athletes' course is available in twenty-three languages, the coaches' course in seventeen languages, and the medical professionals' course is offered in three languages. Each course takes up to 2-3 hours to complete. The courses can also be accessed through the “**ADEL by WADA**” mobile application.

Step 5:

Once the course has been successfully completed, download the certificate of completion, and send it to your World Aquatics Member. The ADEL guidelines to download the certificate can be found [here](#). Step 6:

The World Aquatics Member must upload the certificate of completion of each athlete on their respective GMS profile [here](#) (in the Sport tab).


Athletes and team officials are encouraged to renew their certifications every four years to stay up to date with the latest anti-doping regulations and procedures.
