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## **PRESIDENT'S MESSAGE**

### **World Aquatics Diving World Cup 2026**



Dear friends,

It is my great pleasure to welcome you to the 2026 edition of the World Aquatics Diving World Cup. This year's series will be hosted across three cities with proud aquatic traditions, each offering a distinctive setting for the world's best divers to showcase their talent on the global stage.

Once again, the world's diving elite return to Montreal, Canada, to open the 2026 Diving World Cup from 26 February to 1 March. A renowned host of major sporting events – including the 1976 Olympics and 2005 World Aquatics Championships – Montreal has a rich diving history, having hosted 14 World Aquatics Diving World Cup and Grand Prix events, as well as the 2022 World Junior Diving Championships. The historic Montreal Olympic pool - a hub for both community and elite sport for over 50 years - will once again be the competition venue.

From Montreal, the Diving World Cup moves to Guadalajara, Mexico, from 5–8 March 2026, marking the second consecutive year the city hosts the event. With Olympic diving medals in every Summer Games since 1932, Mexico has long been a cornerstone of the sport. The Centre Acuático Code Metropolitano – home to many of the country's top athletes – will provide a fitting backdrop for a memorable competition.

Following Guadalajara, the Diving World Cup concludes in Beijing, China, with the Super Final from 1–3 May 2026. The iconic Water Cube, officially the National Aquatics Centre, will host the world's top divers. Steeped in Olympic history, including the 2008 Games, Beijing has also staged 11 World Aquatics Diving World Cups. With its passionate fans and strong commitment to elite aquatics, the city provides a fitting finale for the 2026 tour.

With the build-up to the 2027 World Aquatics Championships and the LA28 Olympic Games in sight – not to mention Beijing hosting the World Aquatics Championships in 2029- this year's Diving World Cup series serves as a vital stage in the athlete's journey towards one of the most action-packed and crucial periods in the sport's history.

I want to extend my sincere gratitude to our host cities, local organisers, volunteers, and everyone working behind the scenes to bring these events to life – your efforts are extremely valued and appreciated.

To all the divers, I wish you the very best. Enjoy the competition, have pride and embrace this important moment in your career!

## 02 RULES & FORMAT

The World Aquatics Diving World Cup - Montréal will be conducted under AQUA diving rules. Please refer to the World Aquatics Diving World Cup 2026 Rules and Regulations, available [HERE](#), for comprehensive details, especially on participation requirements and conditions of entry.

The DWC Windsor 2025 will consist of the following 9 medal events:

- Individual diving - Men/Women - 3M Springboard/10M Platform
- Synchronised diving - Men/Women - 3M Springboard/10M Platform
- Mixed Team event

Please refer to the Rules and Regulations for further information on each of the events.

## 03 ELECTRONIC DIVE SHEETS

World Aquatics in collaboration with Swiss Timing will continue using electronic Dive Sheets, as introduced in 2025.

Only one person per National Federation (NF) per competition will get credentials to submit dive sheets electronically on Dive Sheets Manager. World Aquatics will reach out to each of the participating NFs to obtain contact details.

The designated person will receive an email from [no-reply@st-software.com](mailto:no-reply@st-software.com) to log in on the website. They will then have the view of each event to enter their dive sheets.

They will only see divers from their own NF entered in each event. Each event will be open until 24 hours before the Preliminaries or direct Finals as per the World Aquatics Competition Regulations. All phases (Preliminaries and Finals) shall be completed and submitted for each event with athletes entered to participate.

After submitting each dive sheet, the owner will get a confirmation email with the dive list.

## WELCOME & ACCREDITATION

There will be someone from the LOC to welcome you at the airport, at the front entrance of the event venue, AND each host hotel. Accreditations will be handed by the hotel manager upon arrival at the hotel if payment has been received by the HC. In order to facilitate your movement, the LOC will install an information booth in each hotel. Do not hesitate to connect with your hotel manager if you have any questions.

Accreditations will be provided to your Team Manager or Head Coach upon arrival at your host hotel. Your delegation will need their accreditation for entry/exit in the training facility to pass multiple security check points and to receive their meals. An accreditation station will be located at the pool beside the secretariat.

## SPORT INFORMATION DESK

A Sport Information Desk will operate at the competition venue on all training and competition days. Please come see us in the LOC office on pool deck if you have any questions/concerns.

NOTE: All the withdrawal and correction forms must first be approved by the referee and then handed to the Secretariat of the competition.

## LOCAL TRANSPORTATION

As an effort to host a more environmentally friendly event, all participants are either walking distance or very short metro ride to the pool.

### Going from the Hotel Royal Versailles to the Olympic Park

#### VIA METRO

- Exit the hotel via the main entrance.
- Cross the street and then you will see the metro station right there.
- Get on at **RADISSON** station (going towards **ANGRIGNON**).
- Stay on the metro for (4) stops and then exit at **VIAU** station.
- Then it will be a short 5 minute outdoor walk to the "Centre Sportif" entrance.
- Total trip is approximately **15-20 minutes**.

### Going from the Hotel Universel to the Olympic Park

#### VIA WALKING

- Exit the hotel by the main entrance, and turn left.
- Cross the VIAU and stay on SHERBROOKE, continuing westbound.
- Keep walking approximately 500M until you see the CF Montreal football field on your left side.
- Go down the stairs and keep left towards the Sport Center entrance.
- Total trip is approximately **10 minutes**.


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


# Level 1 - Pool

## 09 MEDICAL

### CHIEF MEDICAL OFFICER (CMO)

Dr. Pascal Haddad MDCM, CCFP Dip. Sport Med

#### Medical Services – Official Hours

Dr. Haddad will be on site during all official training sessions and competition hours, serving as the primary medical contact at the venue. He will be based at the medical station on the pool deck.

#### Medical Services – Outside Official Hours

Teams may contact the Competition Director at +1 (819) 210-8652, who will coordinate with the CMO as needed.

For emergencies

- EMS is activated via the venue's EAP and determines transport destination.

For non-urgent consultations:

- Team leaders may contact Delegate Services or present directly to the pool-deck medical station.
- The CMO will assess and direct care as appropriate.

### TREATMENT TABLES

Treatment tables will be available at the pool for teams to use. They will be located near the Dryland area.

Treatment rooms have been set up at both host hotels and are accessible 24/7.

- Hotel Universel - Hochelaga Room (sous-sol)
- Auberge Royal Versailles - Room 220 (second floor)

### MASSAGE THERAPY

A local massage therapy school will provide complimentary massage therapy services on site at the pool for accredited delegates. The service schedule will be confirmed and communicated via the Events Insider App.

## LIFEGUARDS & EMS SERVICES

Lifeguards will be onsite at the competition venue during training and competition to provide first aid. They are responsible to respond to all emergencies in the pool area. The lifeguards are the first responders and are stationed on each side of the pool deck. The team have received specific training to deal with diving emergency so they are prepared and ready.

They will initiate the EMS services procedures in place by the aquatic centre when needed. In case of an emergency, the EMS will decide which hospital the patient will be transferred to depending on the type of injury or illness.

## DOPING CONTROL

Urine and blood samples will be collected during the DWC Montréal 2026 for the purpose of doping controls. The doping controls will be done in accordance with the World Aquatics Doping Control Rules and the World Anti-Doping International Standards, which can be consulted [HERE](#). The operations will be supervised and coordinated by the International Testing Agency (ITA).

The list of prohibited substances can be consulted [HERE](#). For reminder, all athletes are strictly responsible for any prohibited substance found in their sample and it is particularly important for them to check any medication they take against the prohibited list. Additionally, all athlete support personnel are responsible to be knowledgeable about anti-doping regulations and procedures.
