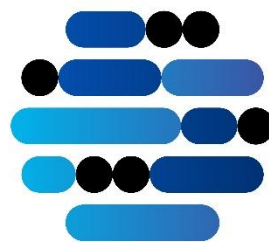

PRESIDENT'S MESSAGE

Dear friends,

It is my great pleasure to welcome you to the 2026 edition of the World Aquatics Diving World Cup. This year's series will be hosted across three cities with proud aquatic traditions, each offering a distinctive setting for the world's best divers to showcase their talent on the global stage.



Once again, the world's diving elite return to Montreal, Canada, to open the 2026 Diving World Cup from 26 February to 1 March. A renowned host of major sporting events – including the 1976 Olympics and 2005 World Aquatics Championships – Montreal has a rich diving history, having hosted 14 World Aquatics Diving World Cup and Grand Prix events, as well as the 2022 World Junior Diving Championships. The historic Montreal Olympic pool - a hub for both community and elite sport for over 50 years - will once again be the competition venue.

From Montreal, the Diving World Cup was scheduled to move to Zapopan, Mexico, from 5–8 March 2026, marking the second consecutive year the city was set to host the event. While the 2026 edition in Zapopan had to be withdrawn, we look forward to returning to the city in the coming years as part of future World Cup seasons. With Olympic diving medals awarded at every Summer Games since 1932, Mexico has long held an important place in the history and development of the sport. The Centre Acuático Code Metropolitano—home to many of the country's leading athletes—will provide a fitting backdrop for memorable competitions ahead.

Following Zapopan, the Diving World Cup concludes in Beijing, China, with the Super Final from 1–3 May 2026. The iconic Water Cube, officially the National Aquatics Centre, will host the world's top divers. Steeped in Olympic history, including the 2008 Games, Beijing has also staged 11 World Aquatics Diving World Cups. With its passionate fans and strong commitment to elite aquatics, the city provides a fitting finale for the 2026 tour.

With the build-up to the 2027 World Aquatics Championships and the LA28 Olympic Games in sight – not to mention Beijing hosting the World Aquatics Championships in 2029- this year's Diving World Cup series serves as a vital stage in the athlete's journey towards one of the most action-packed and crucial periods in the sport's history.

I want to extend my sincere gratitude to our host cities, local organisers, volunteers, and everyone working behind the scenes to bring these events to life – your efforts are extremely valued and appreciated.

To all the divers, I wish you the very best. Enjoy the competition, have pride and embrace this important moment in your career!

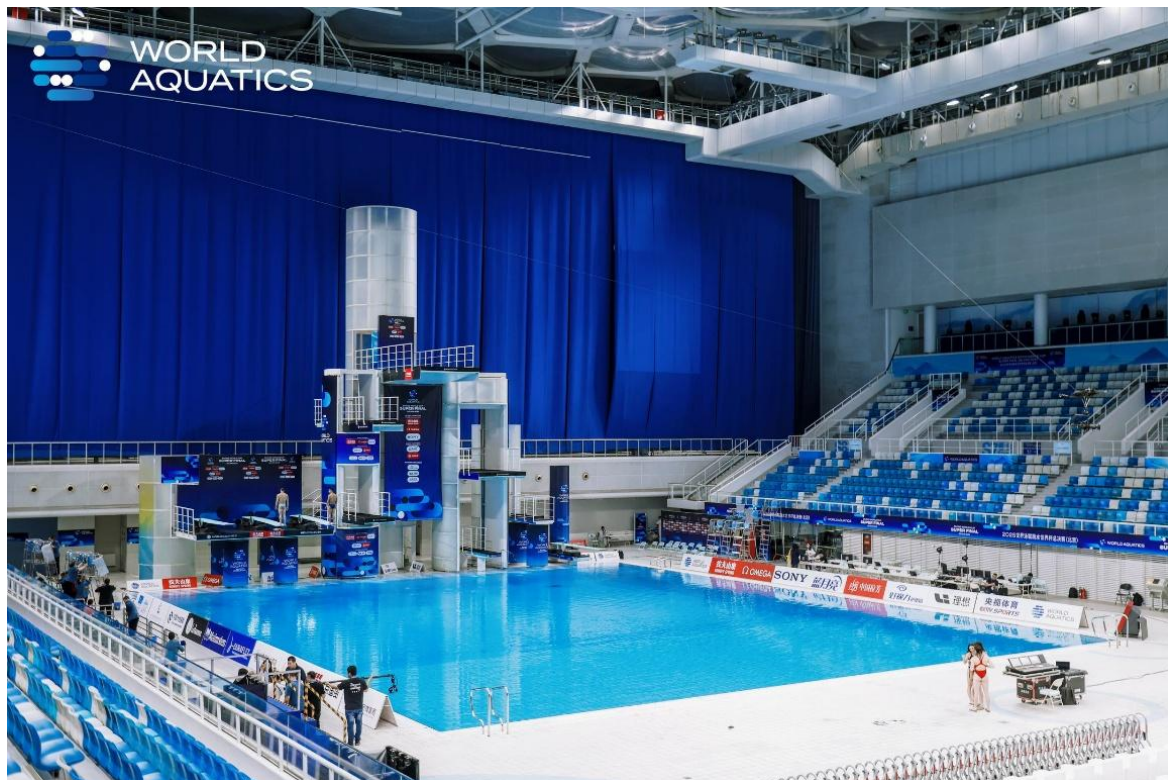
EVENT COVERAGE

VENUE INFORMATION

Competition will be held in the National Aquatics Center. The venue has a construction area of 100,000 square meters, with both length and width of 177 meters and height of 30 meters. As a 4,300-seat indoor arena, it has staged the Olympic Games in 2008.

REGISTRATION & ENTRY PROCESS

All registration and sport entries shall be made electronically via the AQUA [General Management System](#) (GMS) by the deadline of **April 8th, 23:59 GMT**.

Access to the registration system should be via the logins previously supplied to your federation. If you require any assistance with the registration process, please contact gms@worldaquatics.com.

VISA ASSISTANCE

**We strongly recommend that you contact your local Chinese embassy or consulate directly to obtain visa requirements and to prepare your application.*

Visa assistance will be provided to those National Federations that have completed the final registration process in the GMS by the specified registration deadline. This includes the submission of all mandatory data such as photo and an electronic scan of each person's passport.

**Please note that in the current context, we expect that issuing visas will take much longer than in the past and we urge you to begin this process as early as possible to avoid possible travel problems due to delays.*

TRAVEL INFORMATION

AIRPORT TRANSPORTATION

All arrivals and departures are scheduled at either the **Beijing Capital International Airport** or the **Beijing Daxing International Airport**.

Designated LOC staff with welcoming signs (printed with event logo) will be at both airports for pick-up service. Transportation between airports and the official hotel will be provided for teams' arrival and departure. Make sure to enter on GMS your flight details.

Please note that participating federations must submit their flight details via GMS by **15 April 2026. Airport pick-up service will only be guaranteed if the flight information is correctly entered in the GMS.*

LOCAL TRANSPORTATION FOR TEAMS

Free transportation from official hotel to the venue will be provided. Schedule of the shuttle bus between the hotel to the venue will be available on the bulletin board in the venue and hotel lobby.

PARTICIPATION & FORMAT

The DWC 2026 Beijing Super Final will consist of the following 9 medal events:

- Individual Diving Men/Women: 3m Springboard, 10m Platform – Head-to-Head format
- Synchronised Diving Men/ Women: 3m Springboard, 10m Platform – Direct Final
- Mixed Team Event – Direct Final

ELECTRONIC DIVE SHEETS SUBMISSION

World Aquatics in collaboration with Swiss Timing launched in 2025 the use of electronic Dive Sheets. This will be in use for the DWC Super Final. Only one person per National Federation (NF) per competition will get credentials to submit dive sheets electronically on [Dive Sheets Manager](#).

The designated person will receive an email from no-reply@st-software.com to log in on the website. They will then have the view of each event to enter their dive sheets. They will only see divers from their own NF entered in each event.

Each event will be open until 24 hours before the Preliminaries or direct Finals as per the World Aquatics Competition Regulations. All phases (Head-to-Head/Semifinals and Finals) shall be completed and submitted for each event with athletes entered to participate. After submitting each dive sheet, the owner will get a confirmation email with the dive list.

DIVING - RULES

INTERNATIONAL TECHNICAL OFFICIALS

World Aquatics shall appoint the Technical Officials (15) for the Super Final and is responsible for their flights and per diem. The Organizing Committee is responsible for all accommodation, meals and local transportation costs for these 15 Technical Officials.

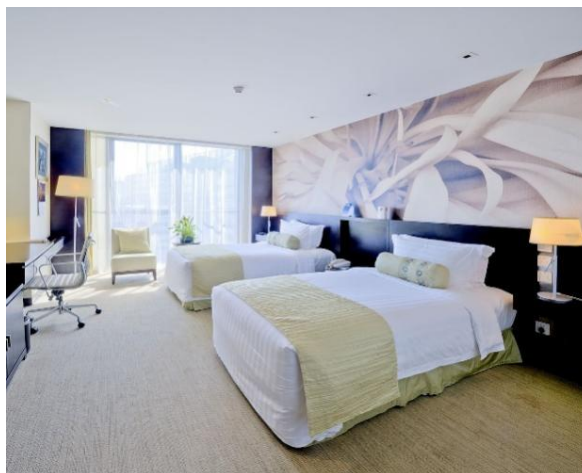

MEDICAL SERVICES

Medical information will be provided as soon as possible.

DOPING CONTROL

Urine samples will be collected during the competition for the purpose of doping controls. The doping controls will be done in accordance with the World Aquatics Doping Control Rules and the World Anti-Doping International Standards, which can be consulted [HERE](#).

The operations will be supervised and coordinated by the International Testing Agency (ITA). The list of prohibited substances can be consulted [HERE](#). For reminder, all athletes are strictly responsible for any prohibited substance found in their sample and it is particularly important for them to check any medication they take against the prohibited list. Additionally, all athlete support personnel are responsible to be knowledgeable about anti-doping regulations and procedures.

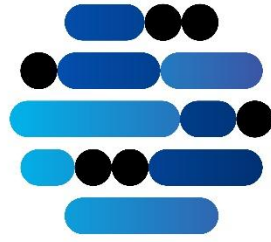
