The venue will have platforms built from the mine with heights as follows: 20m, and 27m.

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Access to the platforms is available via a former mine tunnel of 500m. Access after dives is also possible through a ladder that goes from water level to platforms.

DRYLAND

Limited dryland equipment will be available such as box jump, elastic band, foam roller, fit balls, gym mats.

SPECTATORS

Spectators will be able to watch the event exclusively from the sea, as there is no designated onshore viewing area. As in past Marmmeeting events, boats, paddle boards, kayaks, and other watercraft can be rented locally to enjoy the competition from the water. Citizens of certain countries and territories need a visa to visit or transit Italy. We invite you to get in touch with us as soon as possible and to check the website below to know if you need a visa.

Note. At the end of a gradual process of adaptation to the common visa policy laid down in the Convention Implementing the Schengen Agreement, Italy entered the Schengen system on October 26, 1997.

The strengthening of the common external border was therefore followed by the parallel and gradual abolition of internal border controls. Hence the so-called Schengen Area was achieved with full freedom of movement throughout the countries of all the signatories to the Schengen Agreement.

Upon request sent to hospitality@marmmeeting.com, the LOC will provide visa assistance by issuing an invitation letter. Please note that in the current context, we expect that issuing visas will take much longer than in the past and we urge you to begin this process as early as possible to avoid possible travel problems due to delays.

9. WEATHER

In July, Porto Flavia—located in the Masua area in the southwest of Sardinia—typically experiences daytime temperatures around 30°C and nighttime lows around 20°C. Rainfall is minimal, with approximately 10 mm of precipitation spread over just 2 days throughout the month. The average relative humidity is around 70%. You can expect about 10 hours of sunshine per day, within a total of 14 hours of daylight. The sea temperature in August averages around 25°C, generally ranging between 24°C and 26°C. Tidal variation in the area is minimal, with a typical range of 20 to 30 cm, posing no significant impact on daily operations.

10. PARTICIPATION

Conditions of Entry

- Up to 4 entries per Member Federation for each Event.
- To participate, the high divers must have competed at a previous World Aquatics Event or Red Bull Cliff Diving World Series.
- If a National Federation wants to register new high divers who have never competed at a World Aquatics High Diving Event or at the Red Bull Cliff Diving World Series, the National Federation must send a link to videos where the 'World Aquatics Technical High Diving Committee Safe to Compete Panel' can review and approve accordingly. The videos need to be sent to highdiving@worldaquatics.com before the Sport Entry deadline.
- The Host may enter additional divers to compete for a maximum of 5 per gender.

World Aquatics reserves the right to invite additional high divers to ensure continental representation and gender balance. Such decisions will be made after the Sport Entries deadline.

11. RULES AND REGULATIONS

The World Aquatics High Diving World Cup – Porto Flavia 2026, hosted by Marmmeeting will be conducted under World Aquatics Competition Regulations [HERE](#) as well as the World Aquatics High Diving World Cup Rules and Regulations 2026 [HERE](#).

12. JUDGES

World Aquatics will nominate the technical officials.

13. ACCOMODATION AND MEALS

Hotel rooms and B&Bs will be assigned based on each delegation request. Each delegation should request number of single, double or triple rooms [through this form](#). The rooms will be assigned until availability runs out:

All participants are required to use the accommodation package provided by the LOC. Anyone who does not stay within the designated accommodation will not be permitted to take part in the competition.

Meals will be provided in partner restaurants in Iglesias. Every person will receive tickets for every meal. Persons in accommodations that have no breakfast will also have a “breakfast” ticket. Tickets must always be handed to restaurants before meals. On the ticket you will find a QR code that links to the list of our partner restaurants.

14. TRANSPORTATION

Free transportation only to and from Cagliari International Airport will be provided upon arrival and for departure to athletes, coaches, and team staff who have booked their accommodations through the LOC with the official host hotel.

Transportation between Piazza Sella (Iglesias) and Porto Flavia will be provided on July 9-10-11-12. Additional info on transportation times will be provided on site.

Please be sure to enter ACCURATE travel information in the AQUA GMS by the prescribed deadline. The Organizing Committee will arrange transportation according to the flight details entered in the system

17. MEDICAL SERVICE

On-site medical services will be available to all participants from July 9 through July 13, 2026.

Safety divers will be present at practices and competitions at all times. In case of an emergency, EMS will send patients to a nearby hospital depending on the injury or illness.

More information regarding medical services will be provided at a later date.

18. DOPING CONTROL

Doping control procedures will be in place at the competition. Anti-doping is managed by the Italian Sports Medicine Federation (FMSI). High divers are responsible for bringing government-issued photo identification (or a high-resolution copy of identification) in case of selection for doping control.

High divers are responsible for any medication or supplement they are taking. Athletes under 18 must have a chaperone from their team accompany them during the doping test.

Each registered individual (athletes, supporting staff, NF rep, etc...) must complete a mandatory Anti-Doping education course prior to the event. Click [HERE](#) for the detailed information regarding the course.
