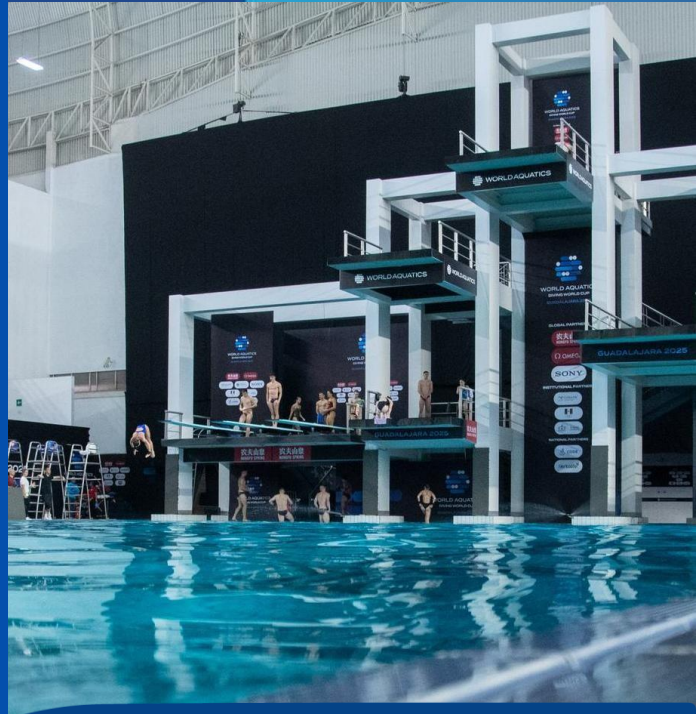

TRAVEL INFORMATION

AIRPORT

All arrivals and departures must be made to and from **Guadalajara International Airport (GDL)**. The LOC will have an information booth in the international terminal.

Please see Diving JALISCOS's staff at the desk when arriving in Guadalajara.

Airport pick-up and drop-off services will be arranged based on the travel details provided by email. Please ensure all information is sent correctly to dir.operaciones@aquaticsmex.com no later than **June 28, 2026**.

VISA AND ETA PROCESS

Citizens of certain countries and territories need a visa to visit or transit Mexico. Click [HERE](#) to find out if you need a visa.

Note. Citizens with a valid visa from Canada, USA, Japan, Great Britain and countries from Schengen Area do not need a Mexican Visa, but need to fill a Mexican format: <https://www.inm.gob.mx/spublic/portal/inmex.html>

Upon request sent presidencia@aquaticsmex.com and operaciones@aquaticsmex.com, the LOC will provide visa assistance by issuing an invitation letter. Please note that in the current context, we expect that issuing visas will take much longer than in the past and we urge you to begin this process as early as possible to avoid possible travel problems due to delays.

WEATHER IN JALISCO IN JULY

In July, Zapopan typically experiences warm temperatures and seasonal rainfall.

Average high temperatures range between 27°C and 30°C, while lows are usually between 16°C and 18°C. July is part of the rainy season, so afternoon and evening showers are common, often accompanied by increased humidity.

Participants and visitors are advised to bring light and comfortable clothing for warm daytime conditions, as well as a light jacket or sweater for cooler mornings and evenings. An umbrella or rain jacket is also recommended due to the possibility of rain during the day.

PARTICIPATION

All World Aquatics Member Federations are eligible to participate at the Copa México 2026, except those under suspension.

Prize Money

- 1st Place: \$3,000 USD
- 2nd Place: \$2,000 USD
- 3rd Place: \$1,000 USD

The same prize money will apply to all event categories:

- Individual events
- Synchronized events
- Team events

RULES & FORMAT

The Copa México 2026 will consist of the following 9 medal events:

- Individual diving - Men/Women - 3M Springboard/10M Platform
- Synchronised diving - Men/Women - 3M Springboard/10M Platform
- Mixed Team event

ELECTRONIC DIVE SHEETS

Electronic Dive Sheets will be used for the competition through Dive Line.

Only one person per National Federation (NF) per competition will receive credentials to submit dive sheets electronically through Dive Line. Contact details for each participating NF will be requested accordingly.

The designated person will receive an they will then have access to each event to enter and manage their dive sheets.

Users will only be able to view divers from their own NF entered in each event.

JUDGES

Each National Federation may nominate, at its own expense, one (1) or two (2) certified judges from the official list (Gold, Silver, Bronze), whether the federation is entering divers or not.

National Federations entering four (4) or more divers must provide at least one (1) judge; otherwise, a USD 500 penalty will be charged to the respective National Federation.

National Federations must seek approval from the Organizing Committee by submitting the judges' nomination through the Dive Line platform no later than June 26th, 2026.

ACCOMMODATION & MEALS

Full board hospitality will begin with dinner on July 13nd and end with breakfast on July 20th, 2026.

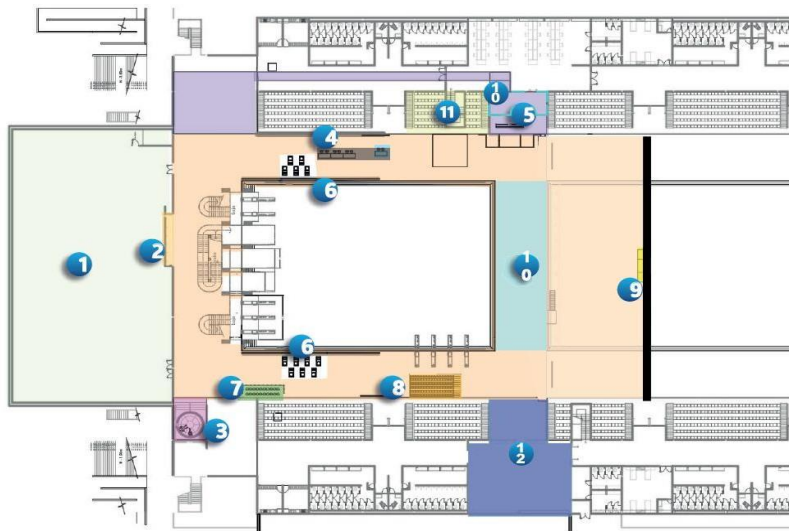

VENUE MAP

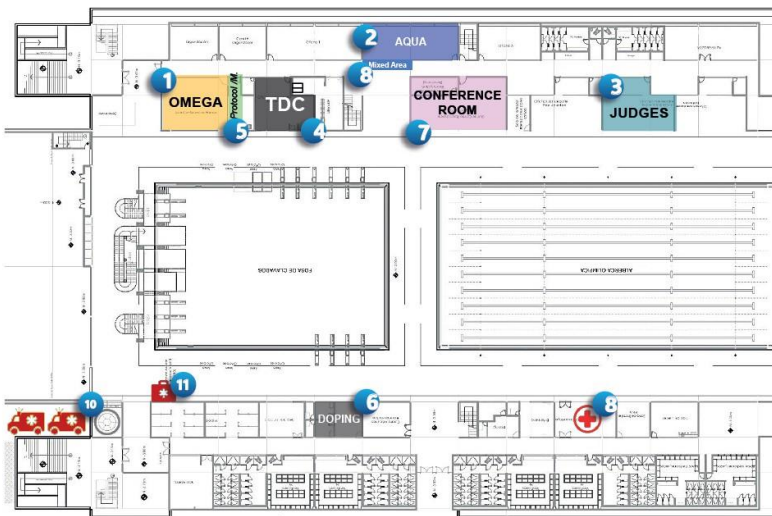

TREATMENT AREA

The medical treatment area is located next to the pool, with two entrances that connect to the area where the intensive care ambulance is parked.

HOSPITALS

- Hospital Real San Jose 3rd Nivel

In case of emergency, the athlete will be transported in an ambulance along with personnel from your country.

In case of a minor injury, the athlete will be transported with a competition vehicle and personnel from his/her country.

Medical care will be provided at the venue from 8:00 PM to 8:00 AM.

On competition days, a doctor will be stationed in a room at the host hotel from 8:00 AM to 7:00 PM.
