DIVING COMPETITION RULES



Information Bulletin

1. MEET INFORMATION :

- a) Date : 30th October – 1st November 2026 – Competition
28th October – 29th October – Training
- b) Venue : National Aquatic Centre, Kuala Lumpur Sport City,
Bukit Jalil, Kuala Lumpur.
- c) Organizer : Malaysia Aquatics
- d) Age : Divers younger than 14 years on December 31st
in the year of the competition shall not be permitted to compete.

2. RULES :

- a) All events shall be conducted in accordance with the World Aquatics Rules, which can be found on the World Aquatics Website.

3. COMPETITION FORMAT :

a) Conditions of Entry

- Malaysia Open Diving Championship 2026 shall be open to all World Aquatics affiliated Federations. Entries of divers will be accepted by World Aquatics Member Federations
- In the Preliminary stage of individual events no limit of participants is requested
- Any Federation/nationality with more than two divers in an individual event may be permitted to qualify to the next stage only with the top two (2) performers in that event. In direct finals only one Team from the same nationality may proceed to the victory podium.
- The Synchro competitions will have a direct Final. Any Federation may enter two (2) teams in the direct final of a synchro event but only the best team may proceed to the victory podium.

b) Judges

- A Federation taking part with a team of four (4) divers or more should bring a World Aquatics Bronze and above qualified judge. The judge might, also serve as coach if this is not for a session where he/she is judging.
- Federation of four (4) divers or more that does not bring a judge will be panelists USD 500.00 payable to the Organizing Committee.
- The Organizing Committee will provide Polo Tee for judges. **Judges are required to bring their own pair of pants and shoes in black colour.**
- World Aquatics will appoint a WA Delegate for this event. The WA Delegate shall conduct judging evaluations and shall report to the World Aquatics TDC Commission and the TDC Judges' Sub-Committee Coordinator.

c) Prize Money

Prize Money shall be provided by the host organizer for all events as follow :

1st Position – USD 200

2nd Position – USD 150

3rd Position – USD 100

In the event if there are only 3 participants or 3 teams in a particular event, only the 1st & 2nd Position will receive the prize money. Similar, if there only 2 participants or 2 teams in a particular event, only the 1st Position will receive the prize money. If there is only 1 participant or 1 team in a particular event, no prize money will be awarded. In any event, if 2 participants or 2 teams tie in any 1st to 3rd position, the prize money will be divided and share accordingly.

Women's individual events	3m and 10m	5 dives without limit
Men's synchro events	3m and 10m	2 dives with limit + 4 dives without limit
Women's synchro events	3m and 10m	2 dives with limit + 3 dives without limit
Mix synchro events	3m and 10m	2 dives with limit + 3 dives without limit
Team Event	3m and 10m	6 dives without limit

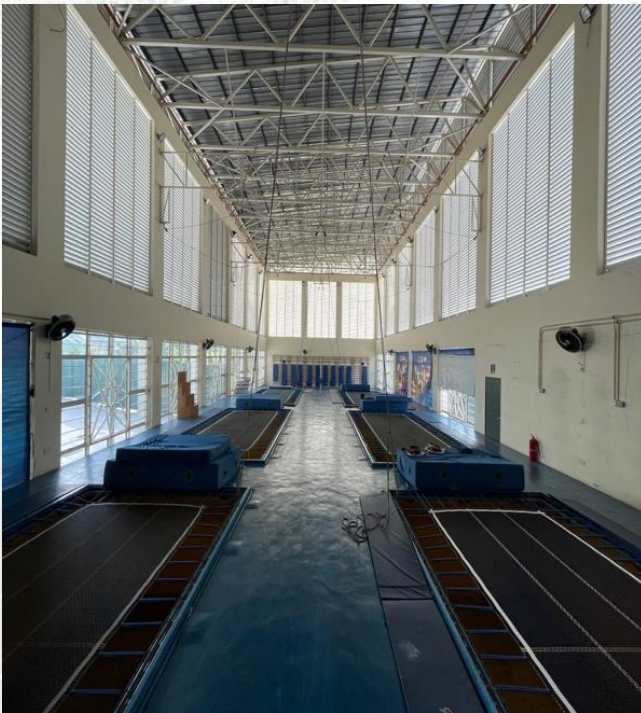
