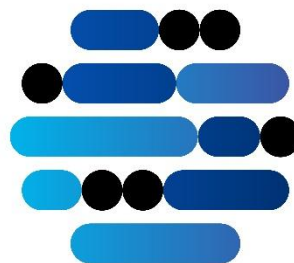

The Diving pool, 20 x 25 x 5 metres, meets all standards for large, international diving competitions.

There are several diving platforms: 1 m (2x), 3 m (3x) and a diving tower with four platforms (3, 5, 7.5 and 10 metres).

In summer months, the pool area can accommodate 378 spectators. There are also seven journalist seats, seven seats for persons with disabilities and four VIP seats.

There will be two (2) areas for DRYLAND:

- On the FOP, under a tent.
- At the gym located within the complex.

A full list of equipment for those two spaces will be shared later.

As part of the public stands there will be a Team dedicated area for non-competing Athletes and Team Officials (partly shaded)

World Aquatics will use the electronic Dive Sheets. Only one person per National Federation (NF) per competition will get credentials to submit dive sheets electronically.

The designated person will receive an email to log in on the website. If you do not receive the email by Tuesday, 18th July, please inform us right away.

Each event will be open until 24 hours before the Preliminaries or direct Finals as per the World Aquatics Competition Regulations. All phases shall be completed and submitted for each event with athletes entered to participate. After submitting each dive sheet, the owner will get a confirmation email with the dive list.

Important notes:

- Dive change, substitution, withdrawal and appeal procedures will have to be done through the respective forms by hand.
- For a dive change between the Prelims and the Final, a federation representative must inform the TDC and Microplus on the Field of Play as soon as the Semifinal phase is completed and fill out a dive change form.

University of Rijeka Campus is a modern academic area located in the Trsat part of Rijeka. It brings together several faculties, student services, libraries and recreational spaces. The campus area includes a gym, outdoor sports fields, IT classrooms and an infirmary. The dormitory has 754 beds for accommodating of full-time students from the University of Rijeka, exchange students, professors, scientists and other guests of the University of Rijeka. All accommodation units are equipped with bathrooms, furniture (bed, closet, shelves, working desk, dining table, chairs and so on) and bedding set. Each room has heating, cooling and Internet connection.

INSURANCE & RESPONSABILITY

The Insurance of the participants is the responsibility of the respective federations. All athletes are under the responsibility of their respective Team Leaders throughout the entire duration of the event. Team Leaders are responsible for the supervision of their athletes at all times, including outside the competition venue and when using public transportation or moving between official locations.

MEDICAL SERVICES

On-site medical services will be available to all participants from AUG 18th to AUG 28th. Two (2) lifeguards, one (1) paramedic, and one ambulance will always be present at practices and competitions, as well as in case of an emergency. EMS will transfer patients to Rijeka Clinical Hospital Center Sušak (KBC Sušak) or to Emergency Hospital Rijeka (KBC Rijeka).

All participants must have medical insurance to participate in the competition.

In any emergency, you can call the universal Croatia emergency number **112** or **194 (ambulance)**, which operates 24/7 and will connect you to ambulance, fire and police services.

DOPING CONTROL

Doping control procedures will be conducted during the competition. Divers are fully responsible for declaring and managing any medications or supplements they use. Athletes under the age of 18 must be accompanied by a team chaperone throughout the doping control process.

Urine and blood samples will be collected during the ASWC Paris 2026 for the purpose of doping controls. The doping controls will be done in accordance with the World Aquatics Doping Control Rules and the World Anti-Doping International Standards, which can be consulted [HERE](#).

The operations will be supervised and coordinated by the International Testing Agency (ITA). The list of prohibited substances can be consulted [HERE](#). For reminder, all athletes are strictly responsible for any prohibited substance found in their sample and it is particularly important for them to check any medication they take against the prohibited list. Additionally, all athlete support personnel are responsible to be knowledgeable about anti-doping regulations and procedures.

Each registered individual (athletes, supporting staff, NF rep, etc...) must complete a mandatory Anti-Doping education course prior to the event. Click [HERE](#) for the detailed information regarding the course.

Anyone registered as an athlete or a team official—including coach, head coach, chef de mission, team leader, support staff, media liaison—for World Aquatics Events, is encouraged to complete the eLearning safeguarding course [Safeguarding Essentials \(Course 1\)](#) or a course recognised by the AQIU (Aquatics Integrity Unit)*, prior to participation at the Event.

Please refer to the Safeguarding Essentials (Course 1) [Registration Guide](#) to access the course. To receive the certificate, complete the course in full. The course takes approximately one (1) hour to complete.

Note: From 1 January 2027, completion of this course will become mandatory for all participating athletes and team officials at all World Aquatics Events.

AQIU Recognised Safeguarding Courses

The AQIU recognises safeguarding courses offered at national level, provided that the course covers, at a minimum, the core areas included within Safeguarding Essentials (Course 1) and that a nominal certificate of completion is delivered afterwards. 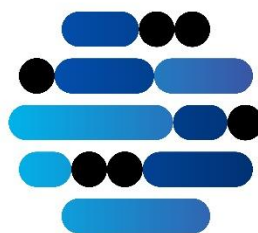
